## II. Review Design Options

The committee members reviewed each calendar option as presented and identified areas of concern. The group decided:

- 1. Each calendar should include the day before Thanksgiving as a school recess.
- 2. We should offer three options to the community: Full-week fall break over Thanksgiving, Full-week fall break in mid-October, and a Traditional calendar with extended weekend breaks in the fall.
- 3. Eliminate consideration of calendar without fall breaks as it only pushes the start of the school year forward by 4-5 days.
- 4. Eliminate consideration of a winter break that starts and ends mid-week.
- 5. 2025-26 will likely not be able to include a week-long fall break due to holidays that fall on a Tuesday or Thursday.

#### III. Next Steps

- Dr. Jeras will review options with Cabinet for feedback.
- Tera and Dr. Jeras will refine calendars for a March 1 meeting, where the committee will approve options for community review.
