 - [Smore.com](#) advertises the workshop program each trimester. Clickable link available for registration with course descriptions and presenters.
 - Google Forms used to register and create spreadsheets by workshop, date, and attendees. Shared with Dr. Shediak and Mrs. Croddick for approval process. Free Google Add-on allows for automated confirmation letter, survey, and Professional Development certificate via email and Google Drive. AESOP has improved the efficiency of SU paperwork and approval.
