After the reading of a brief inspirational paragraph about each recipient, they were provided with a Certificate of Recognition from the State/Board.

Next, Dr. Shedral, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum Instruction, introduced Mary Charmello, Teacher of the Tomorrow's Teacher program. Together with Dr. Shediak, Ms. Charmello introduced and recognized all the participants in the first Tomorrow's Teacher class. After each student received a Certificate of Recognition from the Board, they presented a brief video that they produced about their incredible year in the program.

The Board then moved action items from the Superintendent's Report onto the Board Agenda.

Among other motions, on the Vision 2030 Finance and Infrastructure portion of the agenda, the Board approved the donation of a scoreboard for the Sayreville War Memorial High School athletic field from The Matt Welna Foundation in the amount of \$16,800.00. Additionally, the BOE approved revenue tuition contracts with the South Amboy Board of Education for a student to attend the Project Before preschool disabilities program, and with the Irvington Board of Education for a student to attend the Windsor Learning Center program. It also approved the attendance and participation of five Sayreville War Memorial High School students and one teacher/advisor to attend the Future Business Leaders of America National Leadership Conference in Chicago, Illinois from June 29 to July 3, 2015. Lastly, the BOE approved transportation contracts contained in BID#2015-16-01 for school year 2015-16 and awarded to

the lowest responsible bidder; and the placement of three classified students in out-of-district placements retroactively for the balance of the 2014-2015 school year.

On the Vision 2030 Student Achievement portion of the agenda the Board approved the use of the multi-purpose room at Truman School for “The Battle of the Books” on Tuesday, June 9th. Likewise, it approved of the Sayreville War Memorial High School Video Game Club to hold a fundraiser on June 4th.

On the Vision 2030 Governance portion of the agenda, as well as other motions, the BOE approved the 2014-17 District Strategic Action Plan.

On the Vision 2030 Personnel portion of the agenda, as well as other motions, the Board of Education accepted the retirement of Libby Feldman, Business Teacher at the Sayreville War Memorial High School. Furthermore, it accepted the resignation of Brittany Deutsch, Biology Teacher at Sayreville War Memorial High School. Additionally, the Board approved the Administrative Secretary: Employee Benefits, Lead Grounds Keeper, and Lead Maintenance job descriptions; a leave of absence (LOA) for 2014-15 and for 2015-16; and approved for several part-time secretaries to work their regularly scheduled hours on June 26, June 29 and June 30, 2015. Finally, the Board approved a Summer Hours Sidebar Agreement with the Sayreville Education Association, and the 2015 summer hours and 2015-16 stipends for the Sayreville War Memorial High School Athletic Trainer.

The next meeting will be a business meeting. It will be held on Tuesday, June 16th. During this meeting the Board will recognize and honor the 2014-15 “Top Ten” graduating seniors at SWMHS and the SWMHS GMC Champion Softball Team.
