11 mini buses are currently being used for the Samsel Upper Elementary School & all four Elementary Schools.

4 buses are currently being used for the mid day run for Project Before at the Samsel Upper Elementary School.

### Non-Public Transportation

Vocational Schools and Non-Public Schools We currently transport students to our non-public schools and also provide buses to our vocational schools.

We have 9 Sayreville buses and 4 contracted buses for a total of 356 students we use to transport our non-public school children.

We also contract 7 buses for a total of 118 students to transport them to the various vocational schools.

### Aid in lieu of transportation

Aid in lieu is the reimbursement of transportation costs where no transportation is available to non-public school students. We currently have 199 students who receive this reimbursement.

#### ESC ROUTES

Educational Services Commission provides transportation for our Out Of District students.

We have a total of 27 ESC Routes. 23 are Special Ed. Routes and 4 are Displaced/Court Ordered Routes

34 students are on the Special Ed. Route and 11 are on the Displaced/Court Ordered Route.
