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EVVRS Reporting

- Violence, vandalism, substance abuse, and HIB data needs to be reported to the community during a public BOE meeting at least twice each school year for the following periods:
 - ✧ Period 1: July 1 – December 31
Reported during one of the following months: January through June.
 - ✧ Period 2: January 1 – June 30
Reported during one of the following months: July through December
- Consists of:
 - ✧ Incident Category by Schools
 - ✧ Number of Confirmed HIB incidents by Schools





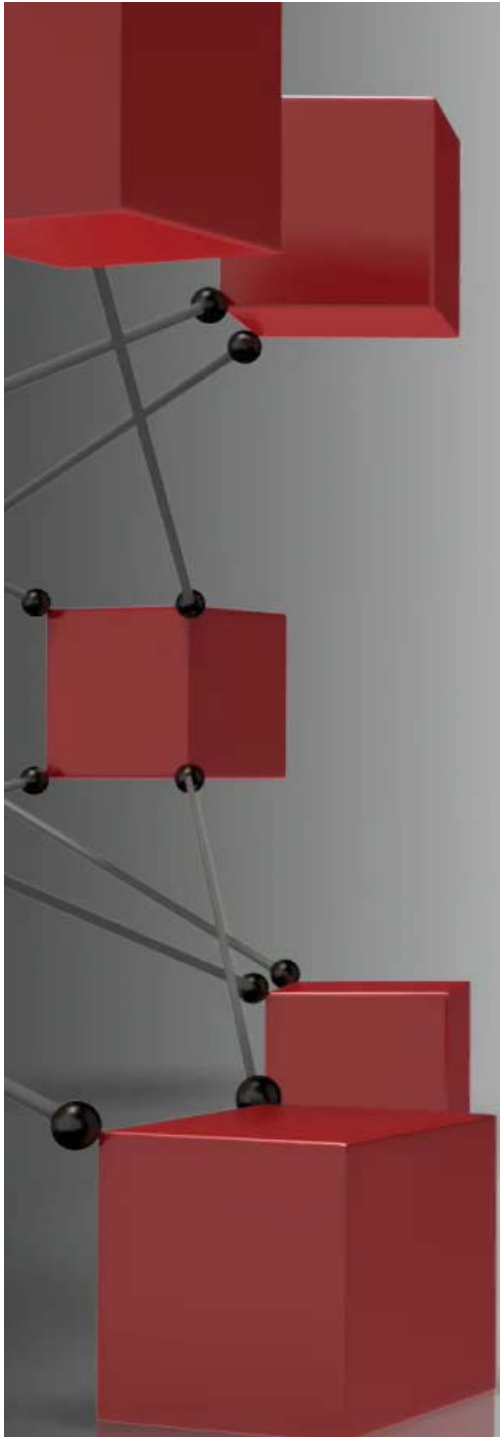

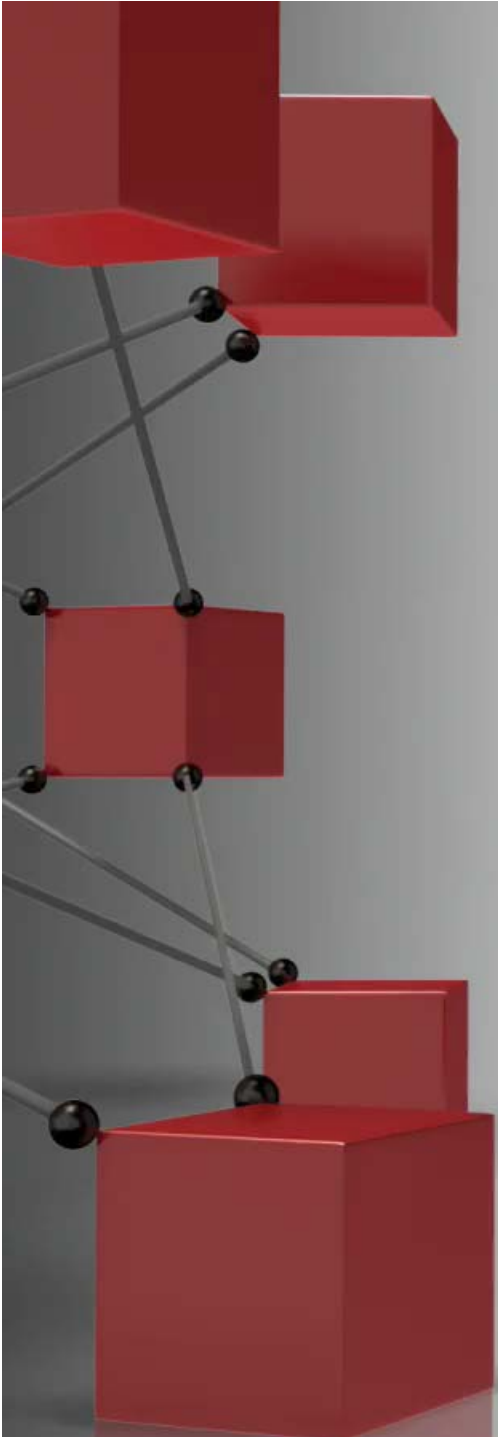

POLICY REVISIONS TO P-6145: EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Revisions to the P-6145 Extra Curricular Activities include the following:



Pupils

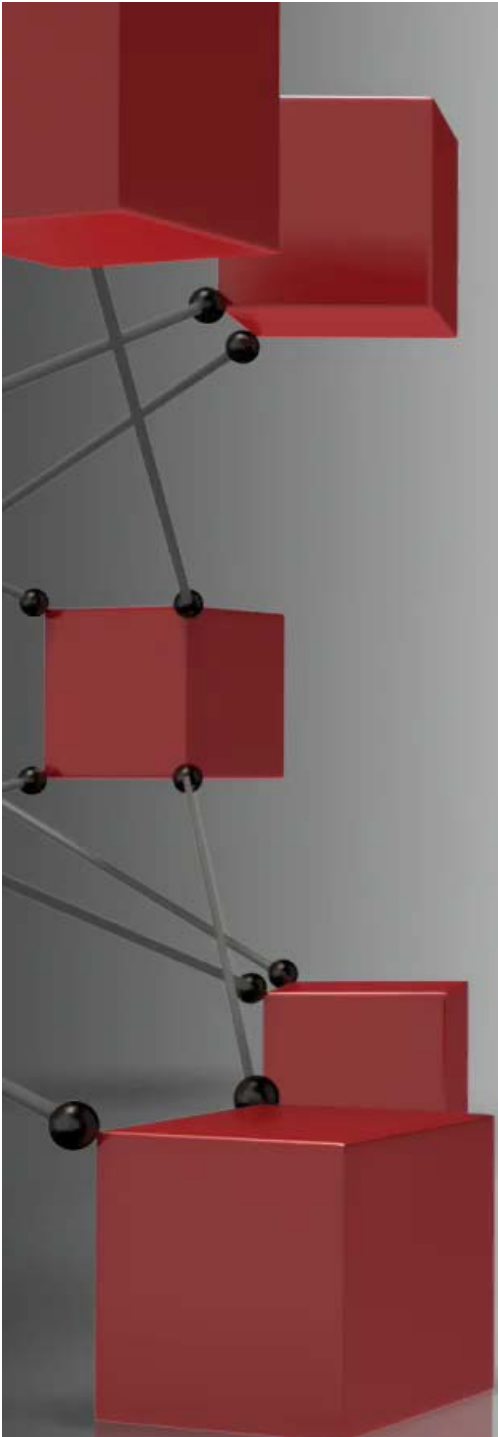
- Sign a Conduct Agreement which includes an anti-hazing clause.
 - *A separate contract must be executed for every activity in which a pupil participates.
- Complete a computer module regarding the definition, danger, and inappropriateness of hazing.

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Parent/Guardian

- Attend a mandatory meeting held by the advisor of each competitive activity, including Cheerleading, to discuss harassment, intimidation, bullying, and hazing, in addition to other pertinent items.
- Co-sign their child's Conduct Agreement.
- Sign a consent agreement for his/her child to participate in the activity.



Advisors

- Complete a computer module on harassment, intimidation and bullying on the General Compliance Network.
 - *This must be completed upon initial employment and twice in a five year period, as per State statute.
- Complete a computer module on Coaching and Hazing on the General Compliance Network.
 - *This must be completed upon initial employment as an advisor, and annually thereafter.



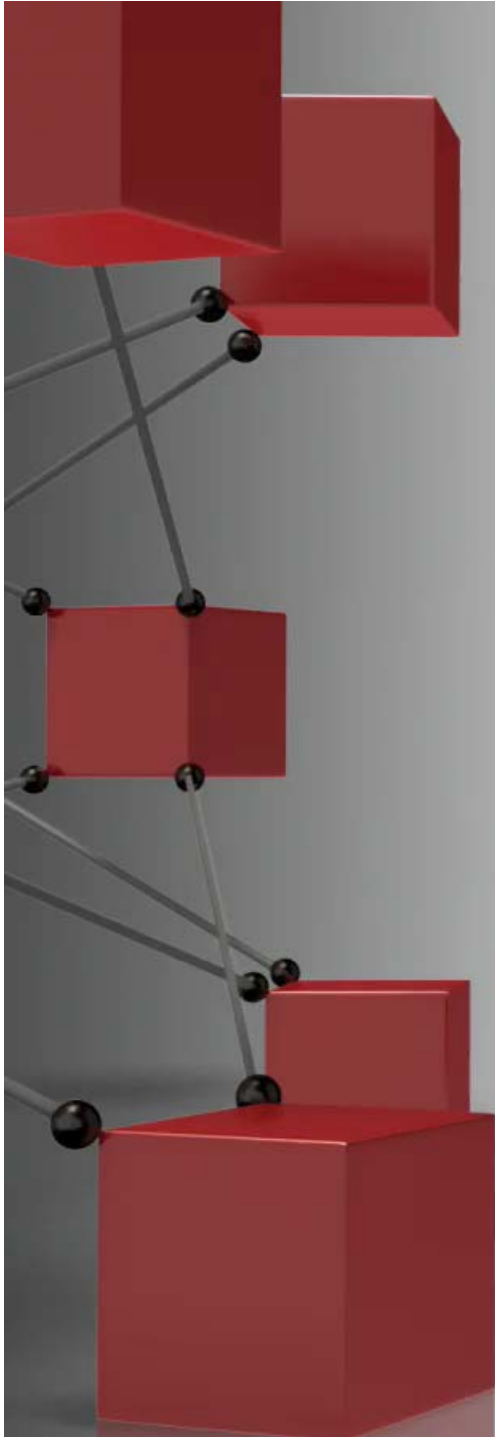
Advisors (continued)

- Coordinate a Parent/Pupil meeting which must, at minimum, review participation requirements, and provide training on Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying and Hazing.
- Sign an acknowledgement indicating receipt of a copy of this policy and Board Policy 4119.24 which defines appropriate staff/pupil relations, including, but not limited to, pupil supervisory requirements.



POLICY REVISIONS TO P-6145.1/ 6145.2: INTRAMURAL/ INTERSCHOLASTIC COMPETITION

- All Parents/Guardians and Pupils must also complete all requirements of Policy 6145 as they pertain to extracurricular activities.
- In addition, Revisions to Policy 6145.1/6145.2 include the following:



Coaches

- Complete a computer module on harassment, intimidation and bullying on the General Compliance Network.
 - *This must be completed upon initial employment and twice in a five year period, as per State statute.
- Complete a computer module on Coaching and Hazing on the General Compliance Network.
 - *This must be completed upon initial employment as a Coach, and annually thereafter.



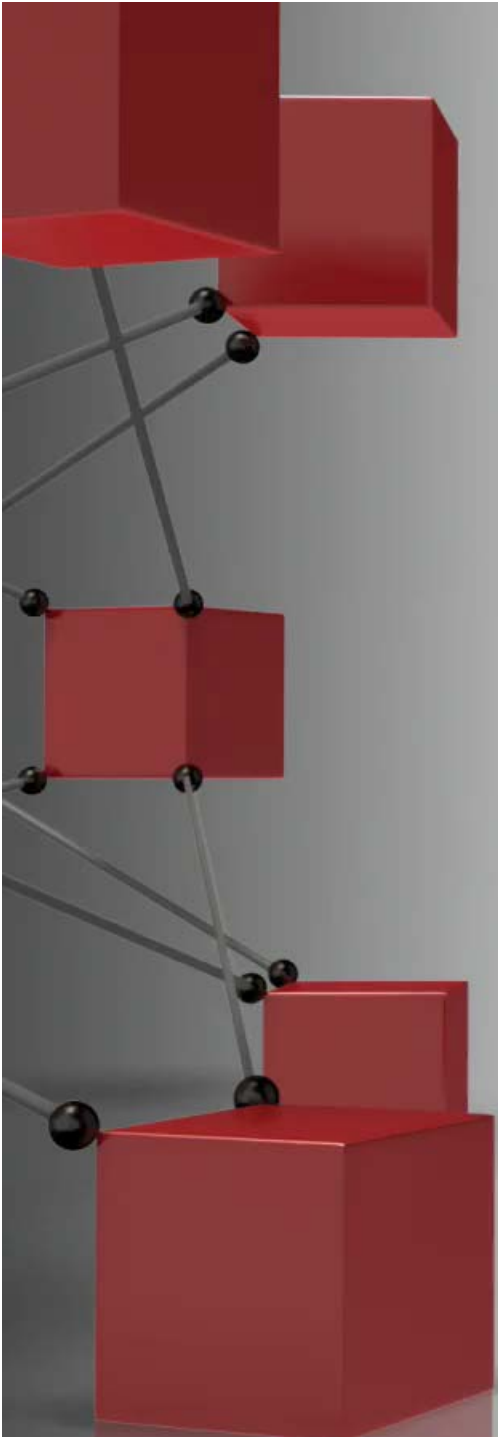
Coaches (continued)

- Complete the mandatory professional development as per N.J.S.I.A.A. regulations:
 - * Current CPR/AED certification
 - * NFHS Heat Illness Prevention
 - * NFHS Concussion In Sports
 - * NFHS Fundamentals of Coaching
 - * NFHS First Aid, Health, and Safety for Coaches



Coaches (continued)

- Attend a mandatory Coaches' meeting facilitated by the Athletic Director, or his/her designee, to review district expectations, policy, and procedures, including supervision.
- Coordinate a team meeting for pupils and their parent/guardian which at minimum must review eligibility requirements for pupils, and provide training on harassment, intimidation, bullying and hazing.



Coaches

- Receive a Coaches' Handbook and sign an acknowledgement of receipt of said handbook.
 - * The Handbook shall also contain a copy of this policy, Board Policy 6145, regarding Extracurricular Activities, and Board Policy 4119.24, which defines appropriate staff/pupil relations, including but not limited to pupil supervisory requirements, as well as their obligations, responsibilities and liabilities as a Coach.



Implementation Timeline

- Immediately upon approval of revisions to Board policy.
