

XIV. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

a. DISCUSSION

- Bond Referendum

A – VISION 2030: FINANCE & INFRASTRUCTURE

FINANCE

20. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the increase tuition cost to Old Bridge Township Public Schools for student #6353912513 to \$41,386.03, previously approved on August 18, 2015, to include speech therapy services in the amount of \$3,841.03.

21. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the following Resolution:

REFUNDING BOND ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE BOROUGH OF SAYREVILLE IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF ALL OR A PORTION OF THE OUTSTANDING CALLABLE REFUNDING SCHOOL BONDS, SERIES 2006 OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, DATED SEPTEMBER 7, 2006, ISSUED IN THE ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$10,000,000, APPROPRIATING NOT TO EXCEED \$7,500,000 THEREFORE AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$7,500,000 REFUNDING BONDS TO PROVIDE FOR SUCH REFUNDING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE BOROUGH OF SAYREVILLE IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Education of the Borough of Sayreville in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey (the "School District") is hereby authorized to refund all or a portion of the outstanding callable Refunding School Bonds, Series 2006 of the School District issued in the original principal amount of \$10,000,000 and dated September 7, 2006 (the "2006 Bonds"). The 2006 Bonds maturing on or after March 1, 2017 may be redeemed at the option of the School District, in whole or in part, on any date, in any order of maturity, on or after March 1, 2016 (the "Redemption Date") at a redemption price equal to the par amount of the 2006 Bonds to be redeemed plus accrued interest, if any, to the Redemption Date.

Section 2. In order to finance the cost of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof, negotiable refunding bonds (the "Refunding Bonds") are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$7,500,000 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:24-61 et seq.

Section 3. An aggregate amount not exceeding \$125,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 18A:24-61.4 has been included in the aggregate principal amount of Refunding Bonds authorized herein.

Section 4. The purpose of the refunding is to incur an interest cost savings for the School District.

Section 5. A supplemental debt statement has been prepared and filed in the offices of the Borough Clerk and the Business Administrator/Board Secretary and in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey as required by law. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in the Local Bond Law and the school debt of the School District is increased by the amount the Refunding Bond authorization exceeds the amount of the proposed refunded bonds.

Section 6. No Local Finance Board approval is required as the issuance of the Refunding Bonds will comply with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 5:30-2.5.

Section 7. The Board President, the Superintendent, the Business Administrator/Board Secretary and other appropriate representatives of the School District are hereby authorized to prepare such documents, to publish such notices and to take such other actions as are necessary or desirable to enable the School District to prepare for the sale and the issuance of the Refunding Bonds authorized herein and to provide for the redemption of the 2006 Bonds referred to in Section 1 hereof.

Section 8. This bond ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS

22. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Sayreville to approve a Boys Basketball Spaghetti Dinner, at the Sayreville War Memorial High School, on Thursday, December 17, 2015, from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm in the cafeteria.

SUPPORT SERVICES

23. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the following trips:

- a. On Wednesday, January 6, 2016, seven students from the Sayreville High School Student Council and two teachers to the College of New Jersey, Ewing, NJ. One Board bus will be utilized at a cost of \$367.99 (salary \$331.69 – fuel \$36.30) to be paid by the Board of Education. Alternate Date: January 7, 2016.

- b. On Wednesday, January 13, 2016, thirty Sayreville High School advanced art students, two teachers and one chaperone to Princeton Art Museum. One Board bus will be utilized at a cost of \$291.35 (salary \$263.85 – fuel \$27.50) to be paid by the Board of Education.
- c. On Saturday, January 16, 2016, twenty Sayreville High School students and one teacher to Monmouth Regional H.S., Tinton Falls, NJ. Students will attend Physics Olympics. One Board bus will be utilized in a four-way move at a cost of \$230.59 (salary \$173.39 – fuel \$57.20) to be paid by the Board of Education. Alternate Date: January 23, 2016.
- d. On Tuesday, February 2 and Wednesday, February 3, 2016, twenty-five students from the Sayreville Middle School and two teachers to Mountain Creek in Vernon, New Jersey to assist Special Olympic competitors. One Board bus will be utilized each date at a cost of \$433.51 (salary \$354.31 – salary \$79.20) per day for a total of \$867.02 to be paid by the Board of Education.

B – VISION 2030: STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT**Discussion Item: Committee Report**

15. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve a program for parents of ELL immigrant students. The program will run two nights each week at Sayreville War Memorial High School beginning January 7, 2016 through June 23, 2016. The program will be funded through Title III Immigrant funds at no cost to the Board of Education.
