## Y10 - Y13 Law Easter Work Experience, Mon 11 April 9am – 4pm

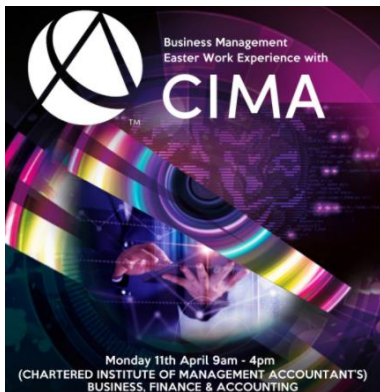

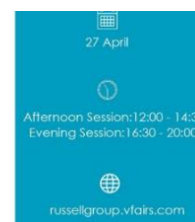
