- 5. The entire application packet, including photo and description of work sample, should be emailed to wvqgscholarship@gmail.com. All documents should be attached to the email. If separate emails are needed due to file size, *make sure your name is included on all file names as well as in the subject line*.

#### **DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION**

Your completed application package must be received by MAY 1, 2020.
