ENTRY FEES

It is the responsibility of each District Meet Director to inform the Regional Director if fees will be paid by each individual school or if the District Chairperson will pay the entire fee for their UIL district. Each individual school or District Chairperson may request an invoice to be sent after the event. An invoice will be sent to those who have miscalculated their entry fees.

ENTRY FORMS

The coach of each qualifying athlete must enter his or her athlete in the appropriate event(s) on the web-based meet entry service www.microsport.com no later than Tuesday, April 26th at 3pm. Once again, email jford@ccisd.net for your link to enter your athletes.

NOTE: Entries MUST include the following:

- Athlete's first AND last name
- Grade Level
- Event Name(s) (all events in which the athlete qualified)

MUST USE AREA MARK/TIME FOR ENTRY INFORMATION; USE YOUR DISTRICT MEET RESULT IF NOT PARTICIPATING IN AN AREA MEET

Entry deadline is TUESDAY, April 26, 2022 by 3pm. You will no longer be able to enter after this time!!!!

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NOTES TO DISTRICT MEET DIRECTORS

- **Area/District Meet Director must certify any scratches and/or additions.** The coach scratching an athlete should contact the Area Director, and the next place coach. The Area Director should verify with the next place coach if that athlete will indeed participate. Once verified, the **Area Director** should contact the Clear Creek ISD Athletic Office (281-284-0084). Please submit the same information submitted via email to: jgrier@ccisd.net
- We will then scratch and add the appropriate athlete **based off the Area Meet Director's email.**

PARKING, TEAM ENTRANCE & SET UP

- Challenger Columbia Stadium is located on West NASA Blvd; Take "Exit 25" from I-45 (see map)
- Buses will park in the SW parking lot of Challenger Columbia Stadium.
- **Participants will enter through the Southeast entry gate. Participants must have their number on to enter free.**
- **Each competing team will receive 5 wristbands for coaches and/or trainers.**
- No tents inside the stadium seating and viewing area.
- Team camps will be on the east side (visitor) stands and concourse.
- **No teams will be allowed in the west side (home) stands as this will be for spectators only.**
- **The fieldhouse will be off limits to ALL COACHES, ATHLETES & SPECTATORS. There will not be a coaches hospitality room.**
- **THE BALCONY OF THE FIELDHOUSE IS RESERVED FOR AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY!!**

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TECHNICAL MEETING

- There will be an important technical meeting for all head coaches of participating teams from 5:00 to 7:00 PM on Thursday, April 28th at the Challenger Columbia Stadium Fieldhouse Community Room, (1955 W. NASA Blvd. Webster, Texas 77598). Information regarding meet protocol and logistical matters will be presented.
- **THIS WILL ALSO BE THE FINAL OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE ANY ENTRY CHANGES.**

TEAM PACKETS

- Team packets may be signed for and picked up at the following times and locations:
Thursday, April 28 - 5:00-7:00 PM (Technical Meeting) – Challenger Columbia Stadium
Friday, April 29 - Beginning at 7:00 AM - Parking Lot Gate 2
Saturday, April 30 - Beginning at 7:00 AM - Parking Lot Gate 2

NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE AFTER 7:00 PM ON THURSDAY, APRIL 28th.

(If you are unable to attend the technical meeting please be sure we have your changes prior to 7:00 pm on the 28th)

UIL MEET RULES

- The first and second place finishers in each event qualify for the state meet.
- Coaches will not be allowed on the track. There will be a designated coach's area for field events.
- Contestants must report on time in order to be entered in any event. Any contestant who fails for any reason to be on hand at the time of the preliminaries shall forfeit the right to compete in the preliminaries and finals of that event. **(UIL Plan Section 1320-J)**
- **No excuse will be accepted for failure of a team or contestant to appear at the announced reporting time.**
- All preliminaries are randomly drawn by computer and ran against time.

ATHLETE CHECK IN

- When athletes present themselves to the clerk for check-in they must be, "run ready".
- Complete uniform must be on their body with number attached to their uniform top.
- Relay team uniforms (shirt and shorts) must be identical.
- Challenger Columbia Stadium track is a Beynon polyurethane pour system. Spike length is limited to 1/4". Tape/Chalk is NOT allowed on the track surface. Relay markers will be provided at each exchange.

Wheelchair Athletes

- Please notify Jimmy Grier, jgrier@ccisd.net, prior to the meet that you will have Wheelchair Athletes trying to qualify for state.
- These athletes are competing for FAT qualifying times and may not receive medals.

VIDEO TAPING

- Athletes and coaches may utilize electronic devices to aid in the athlete's performance. Usage of such devices may not slow down or interfere with the normal flow of the meet.

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN

- Implement weigh-in/check-in will be held 90 minutes prior to the start of each throwing event and can be located in the metal building beside the field event center.
Weigh-in will close 45 minutes prior to each throwing event.

DISCUS SECTOR

- The National Federation rule has required the use of a 34.92-degree sector in the shot put and discus. The 34.92-degree sector will be used at the state meet and we will use a 34.92-degree sector at the Region III Meet.

POLE VAULT CHECK AND VAULTER WEIGH IN

- As per National Federation rules, the competitors' weight shall be at or below the manufacturer's pole rating with a 1" circular band indicating the maximum top hand hold position.
- **Per UIL instructions, all pole-vaulters must weigh in before competition. The designated official will begin weigh in 90 minutes prior to competition. Weigh in will close 20 minutes prior to competition time. It is the Coaches responsibility to present this verification form to the officials prior to competition, to ensure the athletes are competing on the appropriate pole for their weight.**

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RESULTS SHEETS AND FINALS PACKETS

- Heat sheets, results and finalists will be posted on the Home Side Concourse level, as soon as they are available after each event. Finals packets will be available Saturday morning at the Challenger Columbia Field House (limit one per team).
- **We will also post “LIVE” results at www.microsport.com**

ACCESS TO THE TRACK

- Officials will escort competitors to the track prior to each race, as well as to the exit gate upon completion of each race. Access will be allowed only through the clerking area under the scoreboard. Athlete’s **MUST** check in with the clerk in the clerking area before they will be allowed on the track or infield.

PROTESTS

- Protests must be lodged in writing to the designated official within thirty minutes of the results being posted. The designee will notify the Meet Referee.

PROPOSED OPENING HEIGHTS AND INCREMENTS

- The Pole Vault will progress at 6” increments. The High Jump will progress at 2” increments. (This will shorten as we get down to the end to ensure we have the best possible records)
- Opening heights will be announced at the technical meeting.

RELAY PRACTICE TIME

The track will be open at the following times for **relay practice ONLY**:

- Friday 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM 1A ONLY then 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM 4A ONLY
- Saturday 1:30 PM – 2:30 PM ALL for Running Finals
