### Agenda Items Discussed:

- School Improvement Approval Plan was reviewed
  - The allocations for TA's and other areas were discussed
  - PTA support for the Infinity Lab was proposed and will be discussed with the PTA
  - It was suggested to view the STEM lab at Jefferson Academy and the Windridge Stem Lab
  - The stipend for the LETRS training was clarified
  - The role of the math specialist to help support students was clarified
  - Concerns about the HOPE Squad were brought up and it was discussed that concerns should be addressed with the counselor and administration in a separate meeting. The funding would be for a Hope Squad advisor.
  - Clarification on what the role of the advisor was discussed.
  - It was suggested to have a separate meeting to discuss the HOPE Squad input for next year and planned to meet on April 15 after school at 2:00 in the library.
  - The question was asked if the advisor needs to be trained. The district provides materials and information for the program.
  - It was clarified that all requests for teachers will be funded.
- The plan was voted on and unanimously approved.

  - The biggest changes would be to allow students to wear smart watches with limitations for prevent distractions and keep privacy in the school
  - Suggestions were presented to make the policy clear on watches
