- School Improvement Approvement Plan was reviewed
 - o The allocations for TA's and other areas were discussed
 - o PTA support for the Infinity Lab was proposed and will be discussed with the PTA
 - It was suggested to view the STEM lab at Jefferson Academy and the Windridge Stem Lab
 - The stipend for the LETRS training was clarified
 - o The role of the math specialist to help support students was clarified
 - Concerns about the HOPE Squad were brought up and it was discussed that concerns should be addressed with the counselor and administration in a separate meeting. The funding would be for a Hope Squad advisor.
