At that point, six finalists will be determined and contacted. Recommendations for those finalists are then submitted to a Selection Committee who will review the information and choose the recipient of the award. Parents of the winner will then be notified and informed of the award presentation.

Award process

- All applications due in by Friday, April 29, 2022
- Six finalists will be contacted with instructions for further application information by Wednesday, May 4th
- Selection committee to review all information and to choose the recipient of this award
- Award presentation will be on the last day of school
