Instructor - US History/Social Science: The Maine School of Science and Mathematics (MSSM) seeks a self-motivated individual with excellent communication and interpersonal skills to guide its US History program. The Instructor will be responsible for teaching three sections of US History (at the university level) and an additional History/Social Science Elective.

History courses at MSSM are writing intensive courses that focus on excellent research and communication skills that go beyond rote textbook instruction. A willingness to explore multiple perspectives in critical and meaningful ways is crucial, as is an awareness of the evolving field and a willingness to introduce students to the complexities of writing about history.

Qualifications: A successful candidate must have at least two years of successful teaching experience in a formal, academic setting. Preference will be given to individuals holding a Master's Degree in US History or a related field. In addition to teaching responsibilities, faculty members are also required to advise a group of students, host a student club or activity, and interact with colleagues and students in this vibrant academic setting.
