- Two students from each state, Washington, D.C, and 8 countries will attend the VIRTUAL camp which will be held June 27th through July 20, 2022.
- The [National Youth Science Camp](#) is a science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) opportunity. The camp will provide daily lectures and seminars with leading scientists, directed studies alongside visiting and resident STEM professionals and engage in activities in the natural, physical, computer sciences, and creative arts.
