

CONCEPTS AND ROLES IN NEW CONSTRUCTION

Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees

1. Decides what buildings shall be built, when and where, and what equipment shall be purchased for them.
2. Decides on the additions to buildings or any major alterations.
3. Selects and purchases school sites for future plant expansion.
4. Selects and employs school architects and building inspectors as (where) needed.

Superintendent of Schools

The Superintendent of Schools

1. Supervises the development of the building program of the district in accordance with the rules and regulations as set forth by the Division of the State Architect.
2. Directs the planning of all educational features of new buildings or alterations of old buildings.
3. Accepts general responsibility for the adequate completion of the building program in accord with the educational needs of the district.
4. Acts as authorized agent with various governmental officials in the building program.

Superintendent or Designee

The Superintendent or designee develops educational specifications and building planning up to the time of the award of contract.
