III. The Superintendent and Treasurer recommend the approval of the emergency modification of public participation procedures at public school board of education meetings:

WHEREAS, in accordance Executive Order 2020–01D, issued on March 9, 2020, by Governor Mike DeWine, a state of emergency was declared in response to the COVID-19 health crisis; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, Governor Mike DeWine signed into law House Bill 197, that permits the Board to conduct its public meetings through the use of electronic means, during the period when emergency measures are in place, but not longer than December 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Board Policy 0169.1 requires a period of public participation at regular Board meetings, and, in accordance with the new electronic structure of public board meetings, an adjustment to the manner for public participation is needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Green Local School District, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Board will ensure that a means for public participation at regular Board meetings will continue, by alternative electronic measures, during the period of Executive Order 2020-10D and consistent with House Bill 197.

SECTION 2: During the period of time when Board meetings are conducted electronically, any member of the public or member of the media may email a public comment to the Superintendent, Treasurer or any member of the Board. A member of the public or member of the media who wishes to submit a comment shall, as is currently required by Board Policy 0169.1, provide his/her name, address and group affiliation, if any. Written public comments should be limited to two (2) minutes, if read orally. The Board President will read public comments during the Board meeting. Unless extended by a vote of the Board, the public comment portion of the meeting shall be limited to fifteen (15) minutes. All rules applicable to the content of public comments and maintenance of proper decorum remain in effect. Any responses requested, as a result of a public comment, shall be provided consistent with the Board's practice to provide a response from a Board member or member of the Administration within a reasonable time.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board were in compliance with all legal requirements including R.C. §121.22.
