



## PROFILE OF A TVS TLC APPLICANT FOR ADMISSIONS

All applicants for The Learning Center must complete a general Village School application for admission. In addition, we require that a current (within 3 years), comprehensive report of a psychoeducational evaluation with a diagnosis, written by a private evaluator or school psychologist, be shared prior to starting the online application process. This information will be reviewed by our Child Study Team to determine the right fit for TVS. Admission criteria include evidence of average or above-average intellectual capability, a mild to a moderate diagnosed learning difference, grade-level achievement scores in some areas, and evidence of willingness and motivation toward academic achievement. The admissions committee, along with a child study team, will review each completed application. Upon offering admission, the school will then recommend an individualized educational plan, including the types of services necessary for the child to be academically successful at The Village School.

Students that our Learning Center serves are diagnosed with mild to moderate distinctions such as dyslexia, other language-based learning differences, auditory and visual processing, and attentional difficulties.

### **Specific Criteria:**

\*IQ of 95 or above.

\*The Village School of Naples is not a therapeutic, nor Applied Behavior Analysis school. TVS cannot serve students with significant learning differences, Social / Emotional, or Behavioral disorders.
