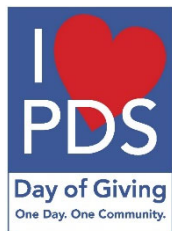


# How to create a CHALLENGE

When you offer a challenge, you set a goal and your gift is contingent on donors reaching that goal. You can make a challenge for a specific group (e.g., the class of '80, all parents, reunion year alumni). You can make your challenge contingent upon meeting the goal, or you can agree to make the entire gift even if the goal has not been met.
