

CLASS OF 2022 SUBSTANCE FREE GRAD NIGHT PARTY INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

The Class of 2020 Grad Night Party to be held starting on **Sunday, June 5, 2022** is a SUBSTANCE FREE PARTY. NO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO OR OTHER SUBSTANCES (DRUGS) ARE PERMITTED.

Where, when and who?

The party may be attended **only** by Jesuit High School seniors who register via the JHS website.

Students must check in at Jesuit High School in the Knight Center Lobby on **Sunday, June 5, 2022, at 8:30 pm**. Parents will be notified if a registered student does not check in at Jesuit for the party by 9:00 pm even if the student has already attained the age of eighteen years. During check in, students will be required to provide emergency contact information and identify who will be picking them up at the end of the event.

Seniors will be transported to and from the main event location by bus, and will be returned to campus by **4:00 am Monday, June 6, 2022**.

PLEASE NOTE: Students will be up all night. For safety, **students may not drive** themselves or anyone else to and from the party and will not be allowed to leave their vehicles at Jesuit High School overnight.

What to wear/bring?

Students should dress casually in comfortable active wear: shorts, sweats, or jeans and non-marking athletic shoes. Students will be asked to drop off their swimsuits before the senior luncheon at school (**on Friday, May 27, 2022**) in a Ziploc bag with their name on it.

DO BRING: Students should bring their cell phones. These will be taken at registration and safely stored during the event and then returned to the student during the bus ride back to Jesuit. Students should also bring any necessary medication and this will be collected during registration by JHS staff to have on site.

DO NOT BRING: Purses, bags, backpacks, keys, cameras, electronics, watches, or money. They are NOT ALLOWED and will be confiscated until the end of the event. All personal items (hair dryers, combs, personal hygiene and first aid supplies) will be provided.

Other expectations

If a student appears “under the influence” at check-in or at any other time during the Grad Night Party, the student’s parents will be called to take the student home, and the student will not be permitted to attend the Grad Night Party. Any inappropriate behavior during the party will be disciplined by immediate removal from the bus or party and parents will be called. **No refunds will be granted under any circumstances.**

Students will not be permitted to leave the Grad Night Party once they have checked in at Jesuit. In the case of illness, a parent will be contacted to pick up their son/daughter from the party venue. The student will not be able to return to the party.

Parents will make sure that the medical and allergy information of their students is correct/updated with the school office. **Contact Susie Rall at 503-291-5495** with any changes prior to the party.
