Junior Majors

Art-Funky Fibers

Discover fabric, yarn, and string as fine art materials. Sculpture, drawing, collage and of course, sewing are just some of the possibilities.

Art- World of Print Making

Students will explore different printmaking methods such as stamping, block printing, monoprinting, and more!

Art- Amazing Animation – FULL

If you want to learn more about animation or already have an interest in animation and want to improve your skills this is the class for you! Drawing skills are NOT required! Learn about the 12 principles of animation, virtually tour an animation studio, and create your very own animations. Experiment with various techniques. Create flipbooks and play around with all the elements of a cartoon such as figure and background drawing, perspective, lighting, lettering, and composition.

Dance

This class will begin with basic stretching techniques that will improve flexibility. Technique such as turns, jumps, kicks, and leaps will be practiced daily. A dance routine will be taught and performed at the end of week showcase. Participants will also have time to collaboratively choreograph their own dance pieces.

Drama – FULL

In this course, students will learn how to perform on stage. We will cover acting vocabulary, how to read a script, and how to add actions and movement. We will also play various drama games and perform in a show!

Music-Junior Band

Come and join the Summer Arts Academy Junior Band! This major will continue to build upon the fundamentals they learned this past year in band at their schools. Students will learn and perform in a full band setting and will perform at the concert on the last day of camp. This gives students the opportunity to perform with other students their age from other schools around the county! Students must provide their own instrument; students who use a school instrument during the school year should ask their band teacher about using a school instrument during Summer Arts Academy.

• Prerequisite: Students should be able to read notes of the Bb concert scale. Students should have just completed one year of successful experience in their school band.

Music- Junior Orchestra

Calling all string players! Do you play the violin, viola, cello, or string bass? Join the Junior Summer Arts Academy Orchestra. The orchestra major will focus on increasing musicianship and instrumental skills. We will learn these skills through classical and popular music as well as games and musical activities. We will perform at the concert on the last day of camp. Students must provide their own instrument; students (including bass) who use a school instrument during the school year should ask their orchestra teacher about using a school instrument during Summer Arts Academy.

• Prerequisite: Students should be able to read and perform notes of the D and A String (String Bass D and G String). Students should have just completed one year of successful experience in their school orchestra.

Junior Morning Minors

Art- Found Object Painting

Students will use brushes and objects for painting that they might never have imagined to create unique and personal artwork.

Art- Walk in Workshop

Artists of all levels will be able to use their creativity to experiment and examine a variety of art materials at their own pace. This will be a true workshop experience where students can open their mind and delve into different art centers. We will have tons of materials on hand, and it will be a supportive environment for students who are beginners as well as more experienced artists will be challenged to learn new techniques. You provide the student, and we will provide supplies and boundless inspiration.

Art- Wonders of Watercolor - FULL

Students will explore different ways to paint with watercolor. Some techniques include wax resist, washes, salt painting, and more!

Dance & Music- Just Dance

Are you interested in getting yourself moving and grooving, but not so sure where to start? This minor course is for anyone who loves to dance but has very minimal experience. We will utilize Just Dance choreography and other online resources to get our bodies used to moving together. Students will get a mind for how choreography works, learn how to build each other up while learning how to move and grow their skills through the anxiety and self-consciousness that comes with dancing publicly! Get ready to sweat!

Music- Beginning or Switching Orchestra

Want to learn an instrument or switch to a new instrument next year? Students will learn the basics of how to assemble their instrument, hold their instrument, and general care of their instrument. They will also learn basic rhythm and notes to learn how to play their first tunes on their instrument. Students must provide their own instrument (strings- violin, viola, cello, bass).

Music-Ukulele

Learn to play the ukulele! Students will spend one hour each day learning the introductory skills of ukulele performance. These skills include how to hold and tune the instrument, fingerpicking, and strumming chords. No ukulele? No problem! CCPS will provide one for you to use at camp.

Junior Afternoon Minors

Art- Bodacious Blue Bin Art

Many materials used throughout the week will be recycled or eco-friendly as we will keep in mind the importance of conservation by using old items in a new, fun, and exciting way. Artists will make new things while recycling and sparking their imagination as they explore these non-traditional art materials. For example, we will be creating luminaries as well as Shrinky Dinks out of recycled plastic containers as two examples!

Art- Magnificent Mosaics
