Board of Education Resolution....

Resolution Approved March 23, 2021

"WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Onteora school board to consider the health and well being of our students; and

WHEREAS, our districts' future well-being relies on a high-quality public education system that prepares all students for college, careers, democracy, and lifelong learning; and WHEREAS, there is substantial documentation regarding the later school start times benefit to student health and wellness by many accredited organizations such as The American Academy of Pediatrics and others; and

WHEREAS, our Onteora school board commits to an engagement throughout the 2021-2022 school year with all the stakeholders in our community regarding school start times, in order to facilitate best practices, and possibilities including direct communication in the form of meetings, forums, etc.; and

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Onteora School Board, in order to support student wellness resolves to move secondary start times to no earlier than 8am by September 2022."

Major Considerations

- Move secondary start time later by 20 minutes
- Maintain integrity of our academic program
- Ensure A.M./P.M./full day BOCES students have access to programs

- Maintain integrity of athletic programming in regards to scheduling/transportation
- Minimize impact to elementary scheduling
- Maintain after school programming at all levels



Major Considerations

- Create realistic transportation schedules
- Adhere to employee contractual agreements
- Comply with NYS attendance regulations: 180 days of instruction, 900 instructional hours elementary/ 990 instructional hours grades 7-12

- Additional Barriers
 - -Middle School requires 9 periods to satisfy requirements
 - -14 cross-over teachers at the middle and high school level
 - BOCES start/end times and mandated certification hours
 - -Daylight for athletic events
 - -Section IX/MHAL scheduling

- Career and Tech Students
 - 2021-22: Approximately 54 students
 - -PM BOCES begins 11:35 am
 - -Students would attend Onteora periods 1-4
 - . Students may need to leave period 4 approximately 5 minutes early
 - . Students need to order bag

lunch

- PM BOCES ends at 1:50 pm
- Students would return to Onteora at 2:25 pm
- Students would be placed in a study hall (until 2:42pm)



Special Education, Phoenix, TTP, OOD, & P-Tech Students

- 2021-22: Approximately 47 students
- Students will continue to receive transportation via special route



Impact on Students - Athletes

- Athletic Director will work with Section IX to move start times to 4:45 where possible
- Fall season games will need to remain between 4:14 pm 4:30 pm due to daylight issues
- Sectionals/ Championships events will not be changed
- Transportation schedule will be revised & arrival times at events will be shortened
- Safety, Sports specific warmup times an issue

Impact on Elementary

 - Elementary After School Programs begin 3:50 pm
 - Participating Bennett students arrive home (on average) 5:20 -5:35pm
- Review impact with non-school related after school activities (i.e., youth league programs.)




Other Elementary Possibilities
