Day fees are inclusive of daily lunch and tea, most study materials, compulsory visits for GCSE and A-levels, games, CCF subscription, and a lifetime membership of the Old Giggleswickian Society.

After-school activities (3:30pm – 5:30pm) for children in Reception – Year 2 is charged at £6.25 per hour.

Extra charges

The following are not included in the fees: external Examination Boards (e.g. GCSE and A-levels), clothing and purchases from the School Shop, certain trips (to theatres etc), a pupil's personal expenses, some optional curricular activities, examination fees for speech and drama, and the following optional individual tuition:

1. Speech and drama lessons

Individual 30-minute lessons £230 per term

Shared 30-minute lessons £200 per term

2. Music lessons

Individual 30-minute lessons £35 per lesson

Individual 20-minute lessons £25 per lesson

Mixture of individual and shared lessons £30 per lesson

3. Support (including learning support and EAL)

Individual 30-minute lessons (minimum 10 lessons per term) £330 per term

The number of speech and drama and music lessons given in an academic year are in the region of 30, with a maximum of 33. Lessons are charged in the term they are taken so the charge will fluctuate in line with the length of the term.

Half a term's notice is required to terminate individual speech and drama or music lessons.

4. Occasional overnight stays by day pupils

The night rate for occasional overnight stays (subject to availability):

Senior School (year 9 - U6) £85.00 per night

Catteral (up to year 8) £70.00 per night

In certain circumstances, at the School's discretion, there may be no charge for day pupils staying overnight.

5. Exeat stays

If necessary pupils in Year 9 and above may stay at school during exeat weekends subject to prior agreement with the School. For any pupil who has to stay at school an additional charge is made.

Exeat charge for Year 9 and above: £100.00 per day

6. Transport

The School operates a number of daily routes for transporting pupils to and from School. Details of these routes and charges are available on the school website.

School transport can be provided for pupils to and from the airports at Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds-Bradford, subject to availability and pre-booking. A minimum of 48 hours' notice is required. These journeys are charged at a flat rate per trip, the cost of which is placed on the school bill. There is an additional charge made for any journey to the airport that takes place more than 24 hours before or after the published holiday dates.

Flat rate for airport transfer: £120.00

Additional charge for airport transfer: £40.00

It is the intention of the Governors that there are no changes in fee rates throughout the year. However, Giggleswick School reserves the right to recover additional unforeseen costs, such as those resulting from a change in legislation, and this may be reflected in the fees for future terms. Should there be a need to return to remote learning then there may be a requirement to adjust the fees to reflect this.
