The 2022-2023 calendar provides 171 school days.

If additional bad-weather closings require that School add more days to the calendar, the following days may be added: Monday, March 20 (second Monday of spring break), Monday, April 10 (Professional Day), and/or Monday, May 29 (Memorial Day Observed).

Our school calendar, in conjunction with calendars at The Bryn Mawr School and Roland Park Country School, is based on the following assumptions:

1. The school year will generally begin on the Wednesday before Labor Day except when in conflict with a religious holiday or to achieve the requisite number of days (School will begin on Wednesday for the 2022-2023 school year).
2. The Bryn Mawr School Commencement will be on Friday, June 3. Gilman School's Commencement (Founders Day) will be on Saturday, June 4. The Roland Park Country School Commencement will be on Tuesday, June 6.
3. Winter and spring breaks aim to provide a combined total of approximately three school weeks of vacation.
4. We will provide three-and-one-half professional development days during the school year: one and a half days in the fall and one day each in winter and spring.
5. School will be closed for the first day of Rosh Hashanah and on Yom Kippur when these holidays fall on a weekday. We will close the Wednesday before Thanksgiving. School will also be closed to observe Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday, Presidents Day, Good Friday, and Memorial Day.
