

Following the graduation ceremony, Graduates from the Laguna Beach High School Class of 2022 will board buses for the Grad Night event. It is imperative that students be on time, as the buses will not wait.
All Students will be given a <u>wristband</u> prior to graduation ceremony which indicates that they have paid for the event and all waivers have been submitted.
This event will have LBHS parent volunteer chaperones, as well as private security and event staff.
The students will return to the district office parking lot at approximately 2:00 am June 10.
STUDENT BEHAVIOR POLICY:
1. NO DRUGS, ALCOHOL, CIGARETTES, VAPING DEVICES. In the interest of your child's safety, students may be searched by security personnel prior to boarding the buses. Intoxicated students will not be allowed to board the buses.
2. NO FOOD, BEVERAGES OR LIQUIDS OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE BUSES. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ENTIRE EVENING AND MAY NOT LEAVE THE PREMISES OF THE PARTY VENUE AT ANY TIME (including the bus ride to and from the party). In the event of illness where a student needs to leave prior to the departure of buses, the student's parents must be contacted to pick up the student.
3. PARTICIPANTS MUST EXHIBIT APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR that does not interfere with the enjoyment of other participants or event staff.
DRESS CODE:
 Small purses or fanny packs allowed - NO BACKPACKS. Personal items may be searched by security personnel at any time. Wear comfortable clothing and shoes; bring outerwear as this is an indoor outdoor event.
Students may quickly change clothes in the restrooms at the graduation venue following the ceremony. Parents/chaperones will be required to take home their student's personal items, as there is no storage provided on the bus or at the event.
ANY VIOLATION OF THE ABOVE STATED RULES will result in the parent or guardian being contacted to pick up the student from the venue.
