Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

Holy Week is the most important week of the year for us Christians. It offers us an opportunity to engage once again in the central events of the Redemption, to relive the Paschal Mystery. The liturgy during Holy Week is a catechesis that leads us to an encounter ever new with our Lord Jesus Christ.

On Palm Sunday we are reminded of the entrance of Our Lord Jesus Christ into Jerusalem to accomplish his Paschal Mystery. We relive it with our own entrance into Holy Week as a way to unite ourselves with Jesus Christ in our own hopes, sufferings, joys, and sacrifices.

The Sacred Paschal Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of the Lord begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, continues with the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday, has its climax at the Easter Vigil, and concludes on the evening of Easter Sunday.

It is always tempting to busy ourselves with many things and forget the great sacrifice Jesus Christ did for us on the cross and the infinite mercy of God the Father in raising him up on the third day so we can have eternal life.

I invite you to join me as we prepare ourselves to live the Holy Week with an intentional deep devotion, in order to share ever more deeply in the Mystery of Christ. Together with Mary our Blessed Mother we are invited to enter the Upper Room, to remain at the foot of the Cross, to watch the stone of the tomb closed, and to wait with hope for the dawn of the radiant day of the Resurrection.

Please check our schedule for all the liturgies and events during the Holy Week.

May God bless you as you journey into the mystery of our faith.



How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the **physically** or **mentally** ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as **diabetes**. Also excluded are **pregnant** or **nursing women**.

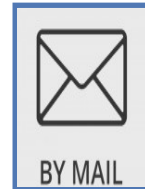
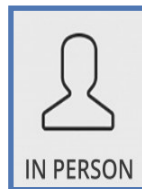

Child abuse can occur in every culture and every socio-economic demographic. Peer reviewed research, especially that of the past 30 years, repeatedly shows this to be true. This same research indicates that the vast majority of child abuse occurs at the hands of someone known to the victim. Those who seek to do harm to children will pursue opportunities that provide access to children and may even ingratiate themselves into the home. You can protect children by respecting the safe environment protocols established at youth serving organizations. More importantly, you can implement many of these protocols in your home and be ever observant and vigilant in all public and private settings.
