



Kindergarten Registration FAQs 2022-2023

How do I know if my child is eligible for kindergarten?

If your child turns 5 on or before September 1, 2022 he/she is age eligible to attend kindergarten.

When can I begin to register my child for kindergarten?

Online Kindergarten Registration will open Monday, February 28th, 2022. The registration process consists of two steps: the completion of a preliminary registration form, **and** the completion of a full registration packet. Once your preliminary registration has been received and processed, you will receive a separate email with next steps for completing the full registration.

What is the purpose of the Kindergarten Parent Orientation Video on the Transition to Kindergarten section of the district website?

This video is for all parents/guardians of children entering kindergarten. The video explains important readiness skills, assessment procedures, and provides more information about the kindergarten program in general.

What is an Assessment Appointment?

*After your child is registered for kindergarten, you will be given a link to select a time and date to bring your child to Lampeter Elementary for a brief skills assessment. This is intended to gather information about your child both academically and socially/emotionally. This appointment is also a time for parents/guardians to ask questions as well as make an AM/PM request. *all appointments take place during the regular school day*

What should my child know before coming to kindergarten?

I am not sure my child is ready for kindergarten and is chronologically young. Is there someone in the district with whom I can speak?

We want all children to be successful in kindergarten. Established readiness skills are essential for kindergarten success. What do I do if I am going to send my child to a private school or homeschool?

What kinds of events happen in the summer to help my child transition into kindergarten?

In the weeks prior to the first day of school a Kindergarten Playground Night is held and Self-Guided Tours will be offered. Dates for 2022 are TBA.
