# Design

The details of the new auditorium complement the style and design of Stratford. The west facade features brick artwork in the shape of the school's mascot, the Spartan. The auditorium has an outdoor plaza and a large two-story open lobby area. The 1,000 seat auditorium has the latest in sound, lighting and acoustics.



### **Improvements**

Campus improvements include the replacement of roof top mechanical units, new roofing systems, added air conditioning to corridors, two additional classrooms, four extra flex learning spaces, and updates to the lobby, reception and clinic areas. The cafeteria also now opens to the commons area, and a collaborative learning space.



#### Athletics

Upgrades to the athletics facilities include the replacement of the two gym floors and bleachers and the installation of a synthetic turf play field.
