WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

- 👉 Children, birth through age 5
- 👉 Children with a Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) indicator through age twelve
- 👉 Living in King County

WHAT THIS PROGRAM DOES:

- 👉 Helps you find a dentist
- 👉 Gives your children a great start in life by making sure baby teeth are healthy
- 👉 Gets children into a dentist as early as age one, as recommended by the *American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry*
- 👉 Provides an easy exam with child in parent's arms, not in a dental chair
- 👉 Prevents tooth pain later on in life

DENTAL BENEFITS:

- 👉 3 fluoride varnish applications yearly
- 👉 2 dental exams yearly
- 👉 2 parent education sessions *per child* yearly
- 👉 Restorative care as needed
