





- Prepping Bunker Hill Elementary for summer 2022

Computer Lockers

- Allow for computer returns, pickup, or exchanges anytime with a code from Technology Services
- Located at MHS, NHS, SHS, SWH, WAIS, and Police Department
- Demonstration

Lifecycle Management

- Yearly process
 - Over 61,000 computing devices in the district with approximately 4,400 devices aging out this year
 - The Bond Program is the primary funding source for student and employee devices at schools and departments
- Why lifecycle management
 - Software and Operating Systems are no longer supported
 - Out-of-date devices pose a security risk
 - Parts are not available to make repairs

 Students and staff will relocate to the South Transition Campus during the Construction Phase in December 2022.
- Nottingham Elementary School Replacement Project: Construction to begin early spring 2022, staff and students to remain onsite.
- Woodview Elementary School Replacement Project: In Design Phase PAT meetings in process. Students and staff will relocate to the East Transition Campus during the Construction Phase in December 2022.
- Memorial Middle School Renovation Project: Renovations to occur summer of 2022 and 2023. Campus will be offline during summer months.
- Memorial High School Addition and Renovation Project: Staff and students moved into new four-story tower January 2022.
 Demolition of several buildings to occur spring and summer of 2022. Project to be completed by end of 2022.
- Northbrook High School Addition and Renovation Project: Renovation scope complete. Staff and students to move into new 18 classroom addition August 2022.
- Stratford High School Addition and Renovation Project: Renovation scope complete. Auditorium to be completed by late spring 2022.
- Administration Building HVAC Renovation Project: Project to be completed by spring 2022.








