Request for Proposal

Pulaski County School District requests proposals for design and recommendation of a solution to provide Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) / Battery Backup protection to all erate eligible network data closets. Equipment lists for each closet will be provided to the vendor. The vendor will make the recommendation of what equipment is needed based on the district equipment to be protected and run-time desired by the district. Pulaski County School District employees will perform installation of Uninterruptible Power Supplies and mounting hardware.

All necessary design/engineering costs, equipment, mounting hardware, warranty and maintenance will be filed under Internal Connections for E-Rate Year 2018-2019 from a vendor with a USAC Service Provider Identification Number (SPIN).

Minimal Technical Requirements

1. Minimum 10 minutes of run time per closet based on number of switches in that closet. All switches have a single 1100watt power supply.
2. Online Double conversion system
3. Rack-mountable
4. Network manageable

Proposal Submittal Requirements

1. Provide separate quotes for each school.
2. Submission must be received on or before February 28th, 2018 by 3:00 PM.
3. All prices are to be effective for one (1) year effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Proposals must be received on or before February 28, 2018 by 3:00 PM and a selection of proposal shall be no later than March 1, 2018.
4. The proposal must be compliant with E-Rate guidelines.
5. All submitted costs must be E-Rate eligible.
6. All submitted services must be E-Rate eligible.

Selection Criteria

1. Any award to be made pursuant to this RFP will be based upon the proposal with appropriate consideration given to operational, technical, cost, and management requirements. Upon conclusion of a successful evaluation, a recommendation will be made to the Pulaski County Schools Board of Education for award of proposal.
2. Pulaski County School District reserves the right to accept or reject all or any part of any proposal, to waive technicalities, and to award items to best serve the interest of the District.
3. The following weighting of the factors listed below will be used in evaluating proposal responses:

<u>Factor</u>	<u>Weight</u>
Overall Cost of Vendor's Proposal	45%

The extent to which Vendor's proposed solution fulfills District's stated requirements as set out in this RFP	10%
The Vendor's stability, experiences, and record of past performance in delivering such services.	20%
Warranty	25%
