Comprehensive School Improvement Plan Goals

Proficiency

By 2024, River Ridge Elementary will increase the combined reading and math percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished from 60% in 2019 to 80% as measured by the school report card.

Gap

By 2024, River Ridge Elementary will increase the combined reading and math percentage of students with disabilities scoring proficient/distinguished from 21.7% in 2019 to 60.8% as measured by the school report card.

Growth

By 2024, River Ridge Elementary will increase the percentage of students showing growth on the Spring MAP test for reading from 58.7% in 2019 to 79.3% and for math from 57.3% in 2019 to 78.6% as measured by Measures of Academic Progress (MAP).

Separate Academic Indicator

By 2024, River Ridge Elementary will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in writing from 63.5% in 2019 to 81.7% as measured by the school report card.

Kentucky Impact Survey

By 2024, River Ridge Elementary will increase the percentage of the adequacy of our school resources from 50% in 2020 to 70% as measured by the Kentucky Impact Survey.
