Student Accounts My Backpack



The school uses [My Backpack](#) to manage student account information for bill payments, online directories, grades, and comments.

Login credentials for parents are the same as the credentials provided for signing enrollment contracts.

Technology 1:1 Device Program



Lower school students are provided a school-owned iPad or small laptop device as developmentally appropriate.

Middle school students are provided with school-owned laptops. Laptops will be distributed during the first week of school.

Upper school students are required to bring their own laptops to school. Students may choose a device based on what best suits their needs and follows the technology requirements.

Learning Management System (LMS)



The Middle and Upper Schools use the [Brightspace](#) learning management system for all content related to student life. The LMS includes class pages for each academic class, class content, viewing and submitting assignments, and other pertinent student information. Both parents and students will have access to the system.

Family and student login credentials will be provided this summer. Class content will be made available in August.

Middle and Upper School students use Microsoft Office 365 email and the Microsoft Office suite.

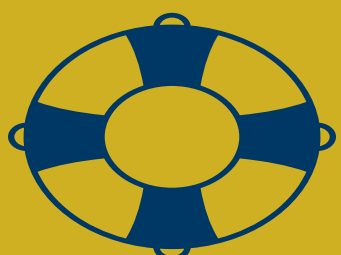
Student login credentials will be provided this summer.
