- Discussion Items:
  1. Financial Report
    - Mr. Schneider discussed financial report with Council. There was no discussion in regards to financial report.
  2. School Improvement Committee Update.
    - Mr. Schneider provided Council with updates from last week's SIP meetings. All members of Council in attendance served on different committees. Mr. Schneider also explained how the process will be different next year with the reintroduction of end of course assessments for proficiency/gap goals. Mr. Schneider reminded Council of the deadlines for completion.
  3. Course Catalogue Updates:
    - Mr. Schneider reviewed changes/additions to course catalogue. There was an introduction provided for language involving dual credit offerings (attached). It was explained that this was a draft and will continue to be updated as we approach the December meeting. Changes/additions discussed were : A Bible Course, Theatre Assistant, Advanced Technical Theatre, AP Computer Science Lab Assistant, Removal of Spanish II Language and Culture, and the addition of a third English IV offering. Council was asked to review the new course descriptions in preparation of December's meeting.
  4. Social Media Parent Night follow-up #1:
    - Mrs. Gatens shared teacher feedback from the Social Media training that took place in October. The training was for teachers and there was also a presentation for all students along with offerings for community members to listen. Some discussion was had about how/where to insert this into HHS. Council felt that using this training during Frosh Mentoring would be beneficial. Also it was suggested to have this done in smaller groups to be more effective.
  5. Policy Review #1 and #9

- Council decided that Policy #1 was suitable and did not need to be adjusted in regards to hiring a principal. Policy #9 was not reviewed. Mr. Haskamp was unable to attend the meeting to share what other schools were doing.
