## Kindergarten Readiness Skills Checklist

Recognize numbers in your environment (telephone number, street address).
Encourage your child to write. Provide several types of writing supplies to make writing interesting.
Encourage your child to talk about their day.
Say the parts of the body while getting ready for the day.
Take your child to the park or local playground and encourage them to climb on the play structures with your supervision.
Ask your child to help you sort the laundry. Can your child help you find matching socks?
Find shapes around your house (circle, oval rectangle, square and triangle).
Use the numbers 1-10 to label an item (rocks, cups, or scrap paper).
Ask your child to use household items to count to 10.
Have conversations with your child throughout the day. Be sure to listen and respond.
Encourage your child to read to you. Ask your child to look at the pictures and tell you the story.
Talk to your child about their friends.
Discuss the rule in your house. (Praise your child when you see them following the rules well).
Make new friends while playing outside at the park.
Be a nice friend to others.
