

Title 1 Services...

READING

Reading instruction focuses on three main areas. The first area is vocabulary. A successful reader develops a bank of identifiable words as well as strategies to be able to decode unknown words. Secondly, students work to increase their fluency. Fluency is how quickly and accurately a student can read a passage. Thirdly, students work on increasing their comprehension skills while reading. Students should be able to identify answers to questions about text they are reading to make sure they understand what they are reading.

MATHEMATICS

Mathematics instruction focuses on number fluency, operational fluency, and problem solving skills. Students need to develop a strong concept of number sense and value with whole numbers, fractions, decimals, etc. Then we use those skills to help develop operational fluency when adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing. All of those skills are used while developing problem solving skills for single and multistep problems. Students gain the realization that mathematics is the study of patterns and increase their confidence in their mathematical skills.

About Title 1...

The purpose of Title 1 services is to improve the educational opportunities of children by helping them feel successful in the regular educational program, attain grade level proficiency, and improve achievement in both basic and advanced learning skills.

Title 1 is a fluid program that students can move in and out of as needed. The classroom teacher and specialist work together to monitor student progress in the regular classroom setting. As a student progresses with their learning, they may no longer require supplemental instruction and will be released from the program.

The Title 1 program is designed to supplement regular classroom instruction in the areas of reading and/or math. These services are provided in addition to the regular classroom instruction. This program allows students to work with a specialist in a small group setting to strengthen their skills.
