Students should continue to send their acceptances, scholarships, and grants to me via email or in person for use in the Graduation Program and future Instagram shout-outs!

Students should decline their other offers of admission if they have committed to a college. This can be done either through the student portal or by emailing college admission offices. If your student needs assistance, they can speak with me or Ms. Kaloudis.

Students and their parents will receive individualized Graduation Booklets from me by March 18th via email. They are due back to me via email by April 12, 2022, at 11:59 PM. These booklets are used by the College Counseling Department to finalize students' college choices, scholarships, majors, etc. We understand students have until May 1, 2022, to make their college decisions, so Ms. Kaloudis and I will work with students individually on this survey if they are unable to make a college decision before April 12, 2022.

Class of 2023

Every student who signed up for the April 13th SAT School Day received an email on March 7th with a payment form. Please submit payment by April 1st.

Students must ask 2 teachers for letters of recommendation by April 8, 2022. These teachers should be from sophomore or junior year. Students can meet with their college counselor to discuss who they are thinking about asking. Students should complete the Teacher Recommendation Questionnaire for each teacher and have it with them when they ask teachers to write their letters. Students were given an electronic copy of the questionnaire. Students should tell their college counselor who agrees to write letters of recommendation for so that the teacher can be added to their Naviance account.

The next optional seminar is Thursday March 24th during Activity Period in Room 324. We will be discussing application platforms and the application process along with helping students create a Common Application account if they wish to do so. Please have your student complete this <u>RSVP</u> <u>FORM</u> if they would like to attend the session.

Students were emailed college essay brainstorm worksheets that were given to us by Brad Simon, our admissions representative from Saint Joseph's University.
