# What is RSN?

In 2018, legislation was passed that allowed the state Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to create and fund RSNs for 3 reasons:

- To help maximize resources for early childhood,
- Streamline enrollment processes for families, and
- Support teachers across diverse settings

Lessons from these initiatives will inform future policymaking.

The purpose of a Ready Start Network is to bring a community together to brainstorm solutions to two major concerns in Early Childhood across the state; access and quality.






