- **5:00 p.m.** Baccalaureate Service will be held in the Church of Christ Uniting, adjacent to campus on the corner of Market Street and Sprague Avenue (*2 guests per graduate*).

In case of inclement weather, it will be held in the Carpenter Athletic Center. - **1:00 p.m.** Commencement will be held on Back Campus. In the event of inclement weather, ceremonies will be held in the Carpenter Athletic Center. For those who are unable to attend, the commencement ceremony will be streamed live.

If Commencement is held outside, 8 guests per graduate will be allowed. If Commencement is held inside the Carpenter Athletic Center, only 4 guests per graduate will be allowed.
