LAKOTA DISTRICT NOTES

COVID-19 Reporting Update

Lakota is pleased to report that as a district, and community, we continue to see a sharp decline in the number of positive COVID-19 cases. On March 10, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) eased the COVID-19 reporting requirements for K-12 school districts.

As a result, Lakota is now able to adjust its practices and treat positive COVID-19 cases the same as other illnesses. The district will monitor for any type of spread, similar to the flu, and in the case of an uptick in cases, will notify families in that classroom or building. However, the district is no longer required to notify parents and staff of each positive case in their child's classroom or report positive cases to the Butler County General Health District. Additionally, March 11 will be the last day that Lakota's COVID dashboard is updated. Moving forward, please know that ODH's "Mask to Stay, Test to Play" quarantine and isolation protocols remain in effect.

Students and staff are welcome to continue wearing face coverings if they would like to, but this is an optional practice. Lakota will continue to promote healthy practices such as proper handwashing, covering your coughs and sneezes and, as always, staying home if you are sick.

There will be no school for students or staff during Lakota's spring break, scheduled for March 14-18. Please also note the professional development day for staff immediately following spring break on Monday, March 21. Students will return to school on Tuesday, March 22.

Summer School Registration Now Open

Lakota's secondary Summer School program is being held May 24 through July 1 (with no school on May 31 or June 20) at the Hopewell Junior School.

Lakota's Summer School program provides an opportunity for students in grades 7-12 to earn original and recovery credit. Students may also participate in summer sessions to help prepare them to retake any one of the Ohio Graduation Tests (OGT) or End-of-Course (EOC) assessments or to participate in select math courses to qualify for advanced math placement the following school year.

Summer School registration is open through April 4 for original credit courses. Registration for high school credit recovery courses will remain open through June 10.
