Lakota Treasurer Announces Retirement

At the March 28 school board meeting, Lakota's treasurer and CFO, Jenni Logan, announced that she will retire on Aug. 1. "Lakota has been my home for the past 11 plus years," she told the Board. "This decision has been one I have personally struggled with, but have now reached a sense of peace and know it is the right thing and right time for me and my family."

Under Logan's leadership, the district has achieved 10 straight years of balanced budgets and eight Auditor of State Awards with Distinction from the Ohio Auditor of State. Both of these achievements are rare for a school district. Click here to read the full story.

Secondary Summer School Registration Closes April 4

Lakota's secondary Summer School program is being held May 24 through July 1 (with no school on May 31 or June 20) at the Hopewell Junior School.

Lakota's Summer School program provides an opportunity for students in grades 7-12 to earn original and recovery credit. Students may also participate in summer sessions to help prepare them to retake any one of the Ohio Graduation Tests (OGT) or End-of-Course (EOC) assessments or to participate in select math courses to qualify for advanced math placement the following school year.

Summer School registration is open through April 4 for original credit courses. Registration for high school credit recovery courses will remain open through June 10.

Nominations for 2022 Lakota Educator of Excellence Awards Due April 18

The Northern Cincinnati Foundation, in partnership with Lakota Local Schools, is currently accepting nominations for the 2022 Lakota Educator of Excellence Awards. Each nomination requires a minimum of three letters of support and the deadline is Monday, April 18.

Two monetary awards will be presented: one to a teacher from the elementary level (PreK-6) and another to a teacher from the secondary level (7-12). The winners will receive a \$1,000 grant to be used for a special project at their school, both awards made possible through a generous sponsorship from Phelan Insurance Agency. The third, non-monetary award, will be presented to a Lakota administrator or support staff member who has shown extraordinary commitment to the students and teachers of Lakota Local Schools as well as the community.
