ADENA PARENT INPUT FOR CLASS PLACEMENT GOOGLE FORM

Each Spring, Lakota elementary school administrators and teachers spend a significant amount of time preparing class lists for the upcoming year. The first priority for class placement in all Lakota elementary schools is to **create well-balanced academic and behavioral classrooms for all students.** In order to accomplish this goal, many factors must be taken into consideration. All schools look at factors such as overall academic ability, value added projections, MAP, AIR assessments, classroom performance, and social interactions to determine placement. We are very consistent in this practice.

Information from your child's current classroom teacher is the first priority in this process. I will meet with our teachers to create balanced class groups for next year. Please complete and return this form only if there are important factors that you wish us to consider.

Your response should focus on your child's learning style or the environment she/he responds to best. If you have critical information regarding class submit here: parent-input form ... by the end of day on for consideration. Your email should focus on your child's learning style or the environment she/he responds to best.

Submissions requesting a specific teacher or forms received after the end of school on May 6 cannot be considered.

All requests meeting these requirements will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible. (Note: some parental class placement requests in the upper grades may not be possible due to enrichment offerings in advanced classes.)

The Northern Cincinnati Foundation, in partnership with Lakota Local Schools, is currently accepting nominations for the 2022 Lakota Educator of Excellence Awards. Each nomination requires a minimum of three letters of support and the deadline is Monday, April 18.

Two monetary awards will be presented: one to a teacher from the elementary level (PreK-6) and another to a teacher from the secondary level (7-12). The winners will receive a \$1,000 grant to be used for a special project at their school, both awards made possible through a generous sponsorship from Phelan Insurance Agency. The third, non-monetary award, will be presented to a Lakota administrator or support staff member who has shown extraordinary commitment to the students and teachers of Lakota Local Schools as well as the community.
