

International Cryptozoology Museum and Tony's



Explore the unknown with us.

Cryptozoology is the study of hidden or unknown animals, and you have discovered the world's only cryptozoology museum. The International Cryptozoology museum was founded in 2003 and is home to a wide range of exhibitions highlighting cryptozoological specimens, oddities, artifacts, and novelty items surrounding the study of unknown creatures. The museum includes exhibits about cryptids (beyond Bigfoot and Nessie) and is filled with unique items, including the full-sized art sculptures of the Crookston Bigfoot (by Curtis Christensen), Freaky Links' pterodactyl (by Haxan sfx), P.T. Barnum's FeeJee Mermaid (by Erik Gosselin), the Naden Harbor Caddy (by Lee Murphy), a life-size bronze of a Thylacine, and other cryptid and new species replicas, evidence, and more.



After visiting the museum, we will stop at Tony's Donut Shop to grab some sweet treats!




