

DROPPING A CLASS

If a student drops a subject before the end of the sixth week, a "W" will be recorded on the permanent record. The seventh through the fourteenth week a "WF" or "WP" will be recorded, and the fifteenth through the eighteenth week a "W (Grade)" will be recorded with the grade counting on the grade point average. No student may drop a subject without the approval of his parents and the principal or counselor.

If a student satisfactorily completes only one semester of a course which has been determined by the principal or recommended by the State Department of Education as a full year course, a grade will be recorded but credit may not be given (unless needed for graduation) until second semester has been completed.
