

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

1. Whenever possible, transportation shall be furnished to all students who live one-half (1/2) mile or more by commonly traveled roads from the school they are required to attend.
2. Transportation shall be furnished to all students who live in an apartment complex, mobile home park or a motel/hotel if any portion of the complex is more than one-half (1/2) mile from school.
3. Regular route buses will not enter any apartment complex, mobile home park or a motel/hotel where the Superintendent of Western Heights Schools or his/her designee and the Director of Transportation determine that for the safety of the students who live in an apartment complex, mobile home park or motel/hotel, due to the bus driver not being able to have a clear view of the drive, not being able to make a circle turn without backing the school bus or other obstructions which make it unsafe or difficult to maneuver a school bus.
4. The bus or buses assigned to students with severe disabilities (or preschoolers with disabilities) will have a bus driver plus a monitor.
  - A. The parent or their designee is responsible for "door to curb," "curb to door" and "street crossing" to the designated loading and unloading point as established by the school.
  - B. Transportation will be provided at the "home curb" unless the Superintendent and or designee and the Director of Transportation determine that the bus driver is unable to do so because of an obstructed view of the drive, speed bumps that are too large, tree limbs, ditches or other obstructions which make it unsafe or difficult to maneuver the bus.
  - C. Transportation will be provided to a designated loading and unloading point if "home curb" delivery is not possible.
