| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Identify process to announce emergency aid to students including instructions on eligibility and how to apply.</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ The information was posted on CMN's website and all students were emailed the information stating the opportunity for the emergency cares act.</li><li>➤ The information provided to students stated they did not need to apply.
