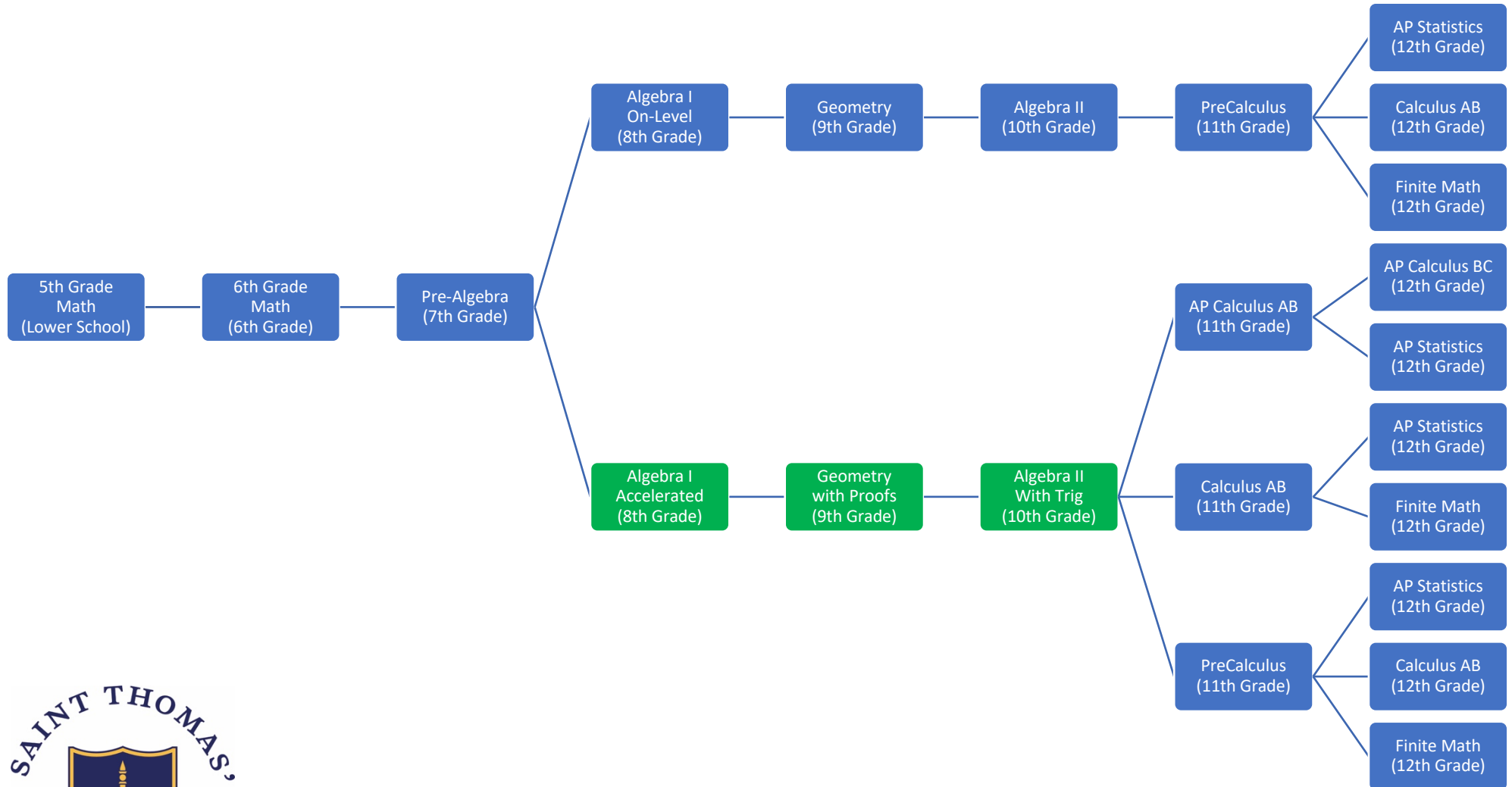

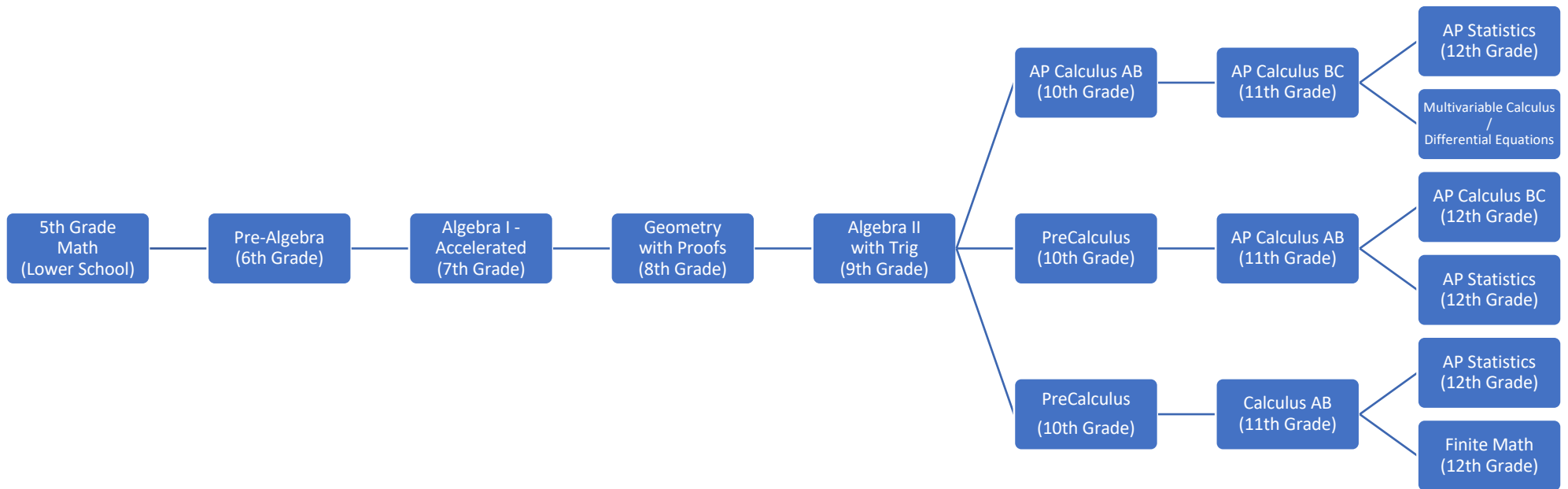

Math Tracks for Students who Passed the 6th Grade Placement Test

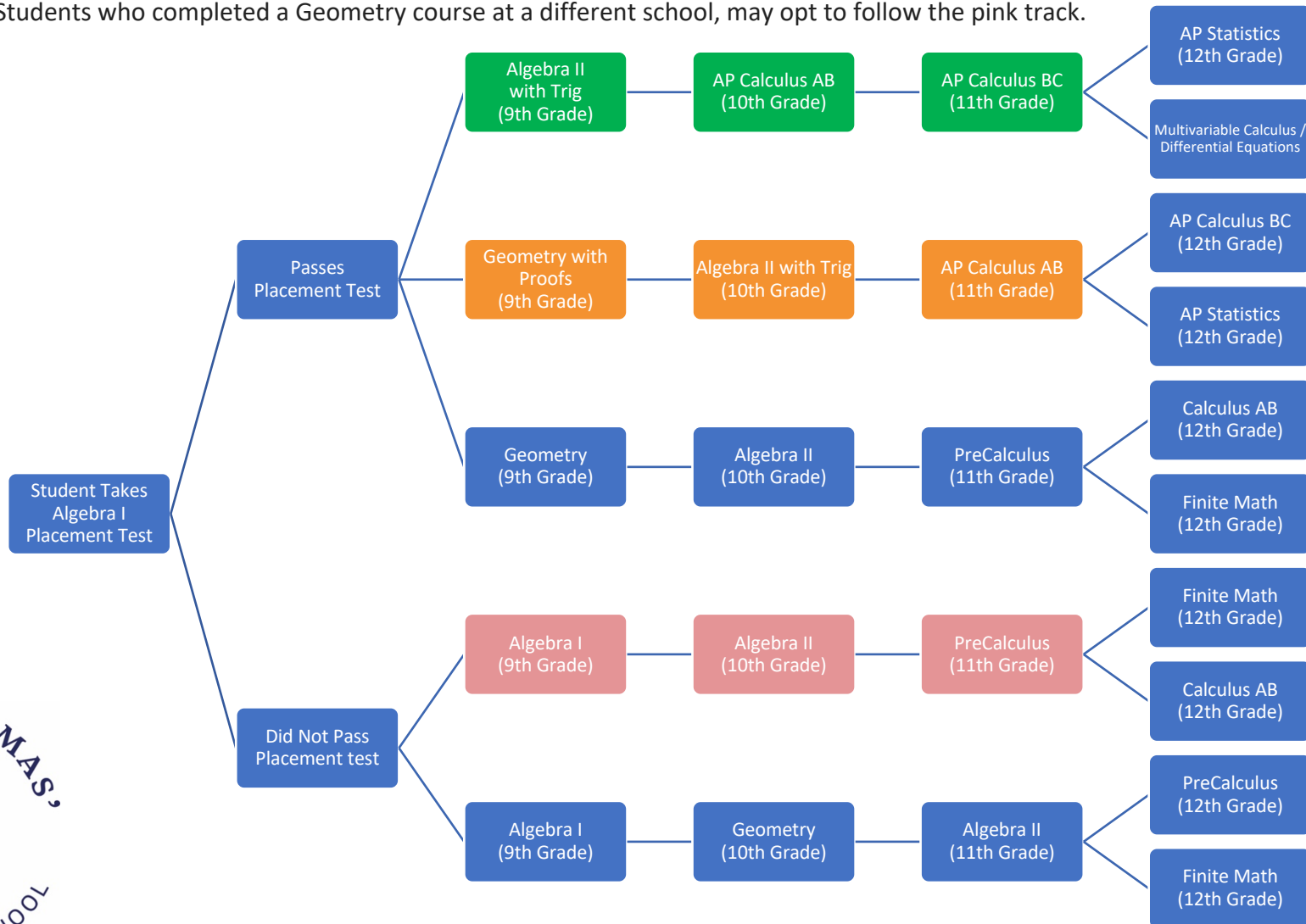
- Any student entering the 6th grade may take the placement test if they meet the following [requirements](#).
- Students who meet the requirements will need to register to take the placement test.
- Parents will receive the registration link before the next school year starts.
- To pass the math placement test, a student will need to score 85% or higher.
- The placement test will be taken on a Google Form (the [following concepts are covered](#) on the placement test)
- This test is designed to evaluate if students have mastered 6th grade math concepts and are ready for more challenging math concepts.
- No other middle school grades have math placement tests.



**To determine which classes, you are eligible to take, check the requirements under each class description*

Math Tracks for New Enrolling Students in 9th Grade

- All newly enrolled 9th grade students will need to take an Algebra I placement test before starting the new school year.
 - Students need to score 70% or above to pass the placement test.
 - Students who score 90% or above and have ISEE scores of 8 or above for each math section will qualify for the green track.
 - Students who score 80% or above and have ISEE scores of 7 or above for each math section will qualify for the orange track.
- Students who do not pass the placement test (below 70%) will need to retake Algebra I in 9th grade.
 - Students who completed a Geometry course at a different school, may opt to follow the pink track.
