MMGM celebrates the geologic and mineralogic history of Maine and explores the origin of Earth and beyond through immersive exhibits, educational experiences, and scientific research. The MMGM houses the finest collection of Maine minerals and gems. It includes the famous Perham Collection, viewed by generations in a local mineral store that operated for ninety years. The MMGM displays one of the world's foremost collection of extraterrestrial rocks – meteorites from Mars, the Moon and the Asteroid Belt - that teach us about the origins of our Solar System, including the five largest pieces of the Moon on Earth.


