**1. Call to Order**

Janet Morgan called the meeting to order at 6:36 pm.

- 2. Board of Education Election Process** – Ms. Morgan asked Attorney Sommaruga to explain an executive order that was signed this evening from Governor Lamont and how it effects the election process. This order will be posted on the Region 14 website at the conclusion of the meeting. Attorney Sommaruga explained that Executive Order #700 has effectively postponed nomination meetings until June 9, 2020. Elections will not take place on June 4, 2020 but will instead be scheduled for a date from June 27-30, 2020. Region 14 will determine the date of the elections and notify the public accordingly. Ms. Morgan apologized for the late notice of the change but explained that the executive order was put into place just minutes prior to the meeting.
