

## Frequently Asked Questions

- If I have more than one child, will they be able to attend the same school?  
**Answer:** There is no guarantee that both of your children will be enrolled in the same school.
- If my child is in Talking Time or Boundary Speech Services, do I need to register my child for preschool?  
**Answer:** Yes - Because Talking Time, and preschool are separate programs, you will need to register your child for preschool if he or she is currently attending Talking Time and you want your child to also attend preschool.
- If my child is on an IEP, do I still need to register my child for preschool?  
**Answer:** No - If your child is currently on an IEP, you do not need to register your child for preschool. Your current teacher will assist you in registering.
- If my child is advanced, can they be placed in a class that fits his/her intellectual age not his/her chronological age?  
**Answer:** Children will be placed according to age. Teachers will provide a rich learning environment and adapt activities that will meet the needs of individual children.
- If my child is turning five on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> and I don't want to enroll him/her in Kindergarten, can I enroll them in your preschool program?  
**Answer:** No – Because we are a district program, we are not able to register children who qualify for Kindergarten. As a parent you have the right to choose whether or not you send your child to Kindergarten or to enroll your child in a private preschool.
- If I withdraw my child a few months into the year and I paid the tuition all at once, will I be reimbursed for the months my child will not be attending?  
**Answer:** Yes – After you have informed the teacher (30 days in advance) and the preschool secretary that your child is no longer attending, you will receive a refund for any **full future** months your child will not be attending. The preschool fee **will not** be refunded.
- If I change my mind, can I pull my child out and still get my preschool registration fee back?  
**Answer:** No – The preschool registration fee is a non-refundable processing fee and you will need to sign a 30-day withdrawal form.
- Will special consideration be given to children who live within the boundaries of a specific school?  
**Answer:** No – Enrollment is limited to a certain number of slots per school.

- Will special consideration be given to children who are already attending a program at a specific school?  
**Answer:** No – Enrollment is limited to a certain number of slots per school.
- Do I get a discount for having more than one child currently enrolled in the program?  
**Answer:** No discounts will be given for having more than one child enrolled.
- Is there an option for reduced tuition?  
**Answer:** Yes – You will need to call 801-402-5409 to see if the child qualifies for reduced tuition.
- How do I pay? Where do I pay?  
**Answer:** You will need to setup a DSD account through the Davis School District.
- Do I have to pay tuition all at once or can I make monthly installments?  
**Answer:** You may pay tuition all at once, if you prefer, although no discounts will be allowed for pre-payment. Monthly payments can be made based on the tuition schedule provided at orientation or at the time of enrollment. The tuition schedule is also posted on our preschool web page.
- If myself or my spouse is a school district employee, do I get a discount on tuition or preference for a location?  
**Answer:** No
- Is there a discount if I pay for the full year up front?  
**Answer:** No
- What is the new Tier Classroom Structure?  
**Answer:**
  - **Tier One:** Student requires minimal support, easily works in any setting, attends, follows directions, participates in classroom activities.
  - **Tier Two/Three:** Student requires medium support, requires monitoring with variable levels of support in attending, behavior and prompting.
  - **Essential Elements:** Student requires maximum support, requires significant support with attending, behavior and prompting.
  - **Social Behavior:** Student requires maximum support, requires significant support with attending, behavior and prompting.
