## Task Force Mission

The Mayor's Task Force on Fire Department Facilities was established by Mayor Breanna Lungo-Koehn on October 1, 2020 for the following purposes:

- To evaluate and assess the current state or repair of facilities currently utilized by the Medford Fire Department; such assessment shall include an evaluation of the current use, industry standards for operation, current needs of the Medford Fire Department, and public safety concerns.
- To develop strategies for bringing the facilities currently utilized by the Medford Fire Department in-line with current industry standards of operation, the current needs of the Medford Fire Department, and public safety needs including but not limited to the reuse, replacement, relocation, or consolidation of facilities; and
- To advise and make recommendations to Her Honor the Mayor as the reuse, replacement, relocation, or consolidation of facilities currently being utilized by the Medford Fire Department.
- The Task Force shall be comprised of the following individuals or their designees, if applicable:
  - One person, selected by the Mayor at her discretion, to serve as Chairperson.
  - No fewer than two (2) individuals and/or residents of the City of Medford with a professional background, experience, or interest related to issues of this type, appointed by the Mayor.
  - The Chief of Department of the Medford Fire Department or his designee.
  - Three members of IAFF Local 1032, selected by the President of IAFF Local 1032.
  - The Chief Finance Officer/Finance Director/Auditor for the City of Medford; and
- The Task Force, subject to available funding or appropriation, may, with the approval of Her Honor the Mayor, employ the services of an Owner's Project Manager (OPM), building specialist, public safety experts, or any other individual or entity that may assist in the completion of this charge. City staff shall be made available to the Task Force to assist with completing this charge.
- The Task Force was directed to begin work on October 2, 2020 and submit a report with their recommendation within one-hundred and eighty days (180) of this date.

## TASK FORCE SUMMARY

The Task Force on Fire Department Facilities convened on October 2, 2020 due to the conditions of the six (6) fire stations in Medford. The Task force with the help of the Captains of each fire station created lists by fire station of serious and ongoing issues, including but not limited to disrepair, damage to the facilities/buildings, and health and safety issues for the men and woman working in these buildings. These lists have been thoroughly reviewed by the members of the Task Force and prioritized by the severity of the issues.

Every member of the Task Force visited each station witnessing first-hand the challenges of working/living in these buildings and the ongoing issues that continue to arise. A detailed list for each station is attached to this report as Appendix A. We recommend work on the stations should commence one station at a time. Each station list is prioritized by highest priority to lowest priority. We recommend work on these stations should be executed from highest priority to lowest.

A list for headquarters is attached to the report as Appendix B. A list of each station with the locations they respond to is attached to the report as Appendix C. We feel headquarters should be the last station to commence work in the hopes of a new headquarters in the near future. This Task Force would like to acknowledge that these lists are not a wish list of issues but a list of serious health and safety issues affecting the facilities and firefighters.

The Task Force unanimously agree that the current locations of the six (6) fire stations within the city are best serving the community in their current locations. The Medford Fire Department (MFD) has great response times and feel very confident about the service and safety of the members of this community. Considering all the expanded development of housing and businesses in and around the Wellington area the task force would suggest building a sub-station in that location. We understand this is a big ask and it will not be easy to secure land in that area. We would like the city to keep an eye on that location and if any future developers want to build in that area for the city to possibly leverage in an area for a sub-station to increase response time with the growing traffic in that area.

The Task force respectfully requests a New/Rehab Fire Headquarters be included in the City's Capital Plan. Due to the current economic decline due to Covid-19 and the numerous other entities in the city that need resources right away the members of the Medford Fire Department understand that a New/Rehab Headquarters will take time to fund. The Medford Fire Department and this Task Force are recommending the city borrow the \$1.5 million dollar loan order that was authorized through the City Council for a feasibility study or planning and development of a New/Rehab fire station within the next two years.

The Task force and the Men and Women of the Medford Fire Department would highly recommend the City explore every option to secure a location in Medford for a Training Facility. When the new police headquarters was built the fire training facility had to be torn down. The Medford Fire Department was promised a new location and training facility. Training is a vital part of any career especially for a fire department, and our fire fighters are only as good as the training and safety equipment they have.

In closing the Task Force would like to express their sincere gratitude to the Honorable Mayor Breanna Lungo-Koehn for assembling this Task force only months into her first term and her continued support of the Men and Women of the Medford Fire Department. Thank you.



## APPENDIX A

### List of Stations prioritized from highest to lowest need

#### Engine 2 Station Repairs – 29 Harvard Ave

Priorities:

1. Install clean zone for all turnout gear and separate fitness area
2. Fix ventilation in bay area so it does not mix with building air.
3. Modify dormitory ensuring privacy for all genders
4. Add a woman's bathroom next to the cleaning closet
5. Replace all windows and repair leak to roof
6. Replace all outlets throughout the station
7. Conduct an assessment of all apparatus bay doors and repair or replace as needed
8. Repair linoleum floor and replace egg create floor
9. Install cord reels in bay
10. Install auto closures and warning lights for overhead doors
11. Epoxy garage floor
12. Currently in progress is new kitchen and new appliances

#### Engine 3/Ladder 2 Station Repairs – 276 Salem Street

Priorities:

1. Apparatus bay floor needs to be replaced and Epoxy coated
2. All windows need replacement
3. Rear bulkhead roof underlayment has failed and need immediate replacement due to safety issue
4. Install backup emergency generator and pad
5. Day room heater needs replacement (on order)
6. Install hood over gas range per code and standards
7. Repoint rear brickwork
8. Remove and seal fire pole to isolate living quarters from apparatus bay
9. Install clean zone for all turnout gear and fitness area
10. Conduct an assessment of all apparatus bay doors and repair or replace as needed
11. Connect existing lighting at bay doors to run in conjunction with doors
12. Install auto closures and warning lights for overhead doors
13. Front concrete apron has failed and needs replacement
14. Install new exit signs and emergency lights
15. Renovate bathrooms
16. Completely renovated second floor including new subfloor
17. Replace all electrical outlets throughout the building

18. Replace all lighting to energy efficient
19. Replace all ceiling tiles
20. Install cord reels in apparatus bay
21. Replace all basement lights with energy efficient vapor tight fixtures
22. Connect station to dispatch/headquarters with fiber optic network
23. Connect fire station with Zetron alerting system to allow for remote control and monitoring of doors and appliances

#### **Engine 4 Station Repairs – 435 Riverside Avenue**

##### Priorities:

1. Needs new roof (leaking in the main stairwell)
2. Replace #1 AC air handler/heating unit in attic and repair any water leaks due to HVAC
3. Replace all insulation in the attic. Almost all of it has been wet numerous times and has created a mold problem. Address mold problem upon removal of old material prior to installation of new insulation.
4. Replace all windows and replace flag pole
5. Conduct an assessment of all apparatus bay doors and repair or replace as needed
6. Replace all electrical outlets throughout the building
7. Install clean zone for all turnout gear and fitness area
8. Remove old exhaust fans and window louvers in apparatus bay
9. Remove and seal fire pole to isolate living quarters from apparatus bay
10. Renovate bathrooms, one has hole through the floor into the bay, the women's bathroom toilet does not flush, and some sinks do not work.
11. Install exhaust fans in bathrooms
12. Repair main apparatus floor does not drain properly
13. Replace all ceiling tiles damaged by roof and AC water leaks
14. Install energy efficient lighting (front living room and kitchen is complete)
15. Install auto closures and warning lights for overhead door safety
16. Install cord reel in apparatus bays
17. Connect station via fiber optic network to fire alarm
18. Expand Zetron alerting system to allow for control and monitoring of doors and appliances
19. Currently in progress - rear yard area needs repaving. Asphalt has failed and a depression has formed which causes the area to flood when it rains. This area is a right of way utilized by Verizon to maintain equipment in an underground vault. The depression was formed over the years by Verizon trucks utilizing this area. The task force has contact Verizon maintenance division to inquire about resurfacing the back lot to restore the proper pitch and possibly install some drainage.

### **Engine 5 Station Repairs – 0 Medford Street**

Priorities:

1. Inspect roof and flashing (concentrating around the cupola and exhaust vents)
2. Clean and repair the gutters, ensuring proper pitch/draining and adding additional downspouts
3. Clean room for turnout gear and separation of work out equipment from garage
4. Conduct an assessment on all the doors including weather stripping/air seal all opening and repair sagging doors (garage/living space)
5. Ensure building AHU (located in garage) is sealed from truck exhaust
6. Modify dormitory and bed partitions ensuring privacy for all genders
7. Replace water damaged ceiling tiles
8. Repair public bathrooms sinks/counters
9. Paint public bathrooms/finish graffiti cover paint job
10. Repair rotted windowsills
11. Entryways need repair and painting/maintenance-free modification (plaster is falling and paint chipping)(DPW may repair)
12. Replace exterior light pack/floods with LEDs
13. Replace high bay lights in the day room with LEDs
14. Replace flagpole lights which are inoperable
15. Gutter ice melt heater is inoperable
16. Repair sunken driveway around catch basin
17. Repair exterior walkways
18. Thermostat access/training
19. Mount radio antenna outdoors
20. Second floor window repair
21. Epoxy/seal garage floor
22. Currently in progress – Kitchen renovation

### **Engine 6 Station Repairs – 2 Ames Street**

Priorities:

1. Replace roof
2. Repair/Replace all soffits with PVC boards and stainless-steel fasteners to prevent further water damage and animal infestation
3. Install clean zone for fitness area
4. Replace all windows and repair rotted windowsills
5. Replace water damaged insulation
6. Renovate all bathrooms
7. Repair/replace water damaged ceilings
8. Replace/restore rotted trim boards on front and rear entrances around the doorway. Front door may require replacement as well.

9. Replace all flooring with low maintenance commercial grade scratch resistant vinyl tile to encapsulate old tile
10. Install central air conditioning system
11. Isolate bay area to prevent cross contamination of the domicile
12. Replace all electrical devices throughout the building
13. Conduct an assessment of all apparatus bay doors and repair or replace as needed
14. Renovate all bathrooms
15. Replace all lighting to energy efficient
16. Expand Zetron alerting system to allow for control and monitoring of doors and appliances
17. Currently in progress – new kitchen and appliances and fiber optic network connection to fire alarm installation



## APPENDIX B

### Headquarters List of Priorities

Headquarters built 1962 at 120 Main Street, Medford

Engine 1 – Ladder 1 – Command – Fire Prevention – Training – Administration

1. Boilers need replacement.
2. Replace hydronic heating units and pneumatic valves.
3. Replace building pneumatic thermostats.
4. Replace garage heating units.
5. Replace underground fuel tank.
6. Air seal second floor from garage (close firepoles and seal gaps where outside walls have pulled away from the floors).
7. Add heat recovery ventilator to the gear storage room.
8. Add heat recovery ventilator to the Decon and washrooms.
9. Add gear dryers to Decon room.
10. Renovate barracks style sleeping to all gender dormitories.
11. Renovate existing men's bathrooms and replace toilets and urinals.
12. Add gender neutral bathrooms and shower facilities.
13. Replace windows throughout the building.
14. Replace ceiling tiles throughout the building.
15. Encapsulate the asbestos flooring on the second floor.
16. Replace the building generator.
17. Replace emergency alert/alarm lighting.
18. Add telecom door answering system.
19. Replace fire alarm system and add carbon monoxide monitoring.
20. Update electrical system.
21. Renovate/move kitchen off the 1<sup>st</sup> floor and replace all appliances.
22. Renovate conference room and add AC and ventilation.
23. Renovate the clerk's office and adjacent bathroom.
24. Renovate the Deputy Chief's bathroom.
25. Renovate Fire Prevention office.
26. Add central AC to all areas on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.
27. Add adequate HVAC to the gym area.
28. Replace interior lighting.
29. Epoxy garage floor.
30. Replace SCBA air fill system.

This list is not a full comprehensive assessment of the entire building only the Fire side. The former Police side of the building is where most of the building utilities and services are located and has been condemned. It is recommended by the Task Force that a feasibility/architectural study be done on the building for full rehab or new Fire building.
